Although opportunistic omnivores, these crustaceans are principally vegetarian and they spend the night foraging on the floors of dams, rivers or streams for water weeds and decaying roots or leaves.

Also in July, we celebrate the anniversary I allude to above. On 21 July 1969 (AEST), American astronauts Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin became the first humans to walk on the Moon's surface, arguably the 20th century's most significant event. While this was an American endeavour, Australia played a role in communicating pictures and footage between the Moon and Earth, so that the historic event could be seen as it happened.

Sustainability is a crucial concept these days, and Stamp Collecting Month invites us into a wonderful sustainable garden. Designed to minimise environmental impact, encourage biodiversity and promote sustainable living, the garden, with its many interdependent layers, is presented through an illustration by Andrew Hopgood. I especially like the pond, which provides bathing and drinking water for wildlife such as birds and frogs, and in doing so supports the natural control of garden pests.

Bush Citrus, to be released in August, is a flora-related stamp issue. The stamps present three of Australia's native edible flora species from the citrus family (Rutaceae), including two from the genus *Citrus*. With high-profile chefs increasingly using bush foods in their dishes, restaurant diners are experiencing some new and unique flavours.

The final stamp issue we present in this edition focuses on two 19th-century voyages to Christmas Island. Both Captain John Fiot Lee Pearse Maclear and Captain Pelham Aldrich visited the island in 1887 and made valuable discoveries. The now-extinct species Christmas Island Rat was named *Rattus macleari* after Maclear.



Australia is home to the world's smallest and largest freshwater crayfish. Many Australian native species are threatened and fishing is illegal without a permit. Australian rivers, creeks and wetlands host at least 143 diverse species of freshwater crayfish. The world's largest crayfish, the Giant Freshwater Lobster (Astacopsis gouldi) is an endangered species found only in northern Tasmania below 400 metres. This imposing craufish varies in colour from brown to blue green, can live up to 60 years and weighs up to six kilograms. The colourful Lamington Spiny Crayfish (Euastacus sulcatus) is typically bright blue with white highlights and red connective tissue.

Classified as vulnerable, the species is found in streams in the highland rainforests of south-east Queensland and north-east New South Wales and individuals weigh around 500 grams. Growing to around 1.5 kilograms, the Smooth Marron (Cherax cainii) is endemic to rivers and dams of south-west Western Australia. The Smooth Marron is usually black to brown in colour with a rare, naturally occurring bright cobalt blue variation commonly farmed for aquarium display.



Photography used in the stamp designs capture the characteristic red subsoil exposed by erosion. Norfolk Island incorporates the main island and two small uninhabited islands: Nepean Island and Phillip Island, which was named in 1788 for Arthur Phillip, the first Governor of New South Wales. Phillip Island lies six kilometres south of Norfolk Island, is volcanic in origin and has an area of 190 hectares.

From the 1790s, introduced animals caused significant erosion to the fragile 2029142 Minisheet \$3

vegetation and soil structure of Phillip Island. Rabbits were successfully eradicated in 1988 and the island is now free of feral animals. Regeneration programs are now rehabilitating and protecting Phillip Island, which is an important breeding site for seabirds and home to rare flora and fauna, including endemic plants, two reptile species and the Phillip Island centipede.

2030142 Minisheet \$4 Fifty years ago, at 12.56pm on 21 July 1969 (AEST), an estimated 600 million people worldwide watched American astronaut Neil Armstrong become the first person in history to step onto the surface of the Moon. As he alighted from lunar module Eagle, Armstrong uttered the now immortal words, "That's one small step for (a) man; one giant leap for mankind". Armstrong was accompanied in the Eagle by pilot Edwin "Buzz" Aldrin, who joined him on the Moon's surface some 20 minutes later, while Michael Collins piloted the command module Columbia in lunar orbit. After 21 hours

36 minutes on the lunar surface the lunar module docked with the orbiting command module and Armstrong and Aldrin returned to Columbia. Australia played a crucial role in telecasting the historic event to television sets all over the world. The actual moments of Armstrong stepping onto the lunar surface were carried via the Honeysuckle Creek tracking station (ACT). After the first nine minutes the Parkes radio telescope (NSW) transmitted the rest of the broadcast. The NASA tracking stations at Carnarvon (WA) and Tidbinbilla (ACT) also supported the mission.



Sustainable gardens are constructed and cared for in ways that minimise environmental impacts, encourage biodiversity and promote sustainable living.

There are some key elements that help to make a garden sustainable and which also benefit the environment more broadly. These elements are showcased in the design of the "In the Garden" stamp issue and include selecting plants that provide food and shelter for wildlife and that attract helpful animals; caring for the soil and not disturbing it too much; managing waste by composting and recycling; fostering seasonal eating through the establishment of an edible garden: and being water-wise. The activities highlighted in the stamps also reflect these ideas: building and

tending to a veggie garden, nest box, worm farm and rainwater garden.

The many layers of the garden are evident in the minisheet and sheetlet scene. There are native trees, shrubs, grasses and groundcover plants that don't require a lot of water and attract pest-eating creatures such as birds, froas and lizards. Manu of these native plants attract vital pollinating birds and insects, which are also the subject of a stamp in this issue. Groundcovers help to keep weeds down too. There's a pond that provides bathing and drinking water for wildlife and a hen house with fresh eggs ready for collection. The garden is fertilised with "worm juice" from the worm farm and irrigated with water from the rainwater tank.





Australia's native edible flora is an important component of "bush food". Species of edible flora are gaining greater public awareness, thanks to Indigenous bush cooking initiatives, commercial bush food enterprises and the increasing use of bush food ingredients by high-profile chefs.

This stamp issue presents three native Australian fruit varieties from the citrus family (Rutaceae), including two from the genus Citrus and one from the genus Acronuchia. There is an outback species: Desert Lime (Citrus glauca), which produces a very small fruit that can be used like a regular lemon or lime – α key difference being its thinner peel. There are also two rainforest species: Lemon Aspen (Acronychia acidula),

which has a very small fruit with a tart flavour. much like that of a grapefruit, and the aptly named Australian Finger Lime (Citrus australasica). The Finger Lime's fruit contains caviarshaped, citrus-flavoured pearls, The minisheet incorporates the Australian Round Lime (Citrus australis), also known as Dooja.

Douglas Mawson's Australasian Antarctic Expedition (1911–14) resulted in a cartographic survey of over 6,437 kilometres of what would become the Australian Antarctic Territory (AAT). Mawson later led the British Australian and New Zealand Antarctic Research Expedition (1929–31) which traced the coastline of east Antarctica. Australian cartographers used this information to produce the influential 1939 1:10 million Antarctic map. From the 1950s to 1970s, the Australian Antarctic Division oversaw the surveying of remote regions of the AAT. Maps were manually composed from ground-level calculations in the field and aerial photography. In the 1970s, satellite imagery allowed for more detailed maps and in the 1990s, Geographical Information Systems used computer technology to produce more accurate maps.

Christmas Island **19th-Centur** Explorers



In January 1887, British Captain John Fiot Lee Pearse Maclear (1838-1907). later an admiral. discovered an anchorage in a bau at Christmas Island that he named "Flying Fish Cove", after his ship. His party landed on the island, making a small collection of flora and fauna. though it was water-damaged on the voyage home.

At the end of September 1887. Captain Pelham Aldrich (1844-1930) (also, later an admiral) visited Christmas Island, accompanied by naturalist Joseph Jackson Lister (1857-1927).



Their party spent 10 days on the island, managing to penetrate further into the thick jungle and successfully scale the island's tallest peak, later known as Murray Hill, after oceanographer John Murray (1841-1914). Aldrich also named Egeria Point after his ship. The partu made valuable collections. Rock specimens sent to Murray were found to contain almost pure phosphate of lime. At Murray's urging, the British annexed the uninhabited island in 1888.

The now-extinct Christmas Island Rat (Rattus macleari) was named after John Maclear.




