Hello Collectors

Welcome to the May–June edition of the *Stamp Bulletin*, and I hope you are all faring well in these unprecedented and anxious times. At the time of writing, our Post Offices – at the centre of communities, particularly in towns and regional areas – remain open to service their communities, and the Philatelic team continues to record our cultural life and natural history in stamps.

A major regional philatelic event affected by COVID-19 was the NZ2020 FIAP International Stamp Exhibition, due to the escalating threat and corresponding restrictions. In support of show organisers, we will go ahead with the release of the show-themed minisheet set, available in mint condition only.

The Navigating History stamp issue commemorates a significant event in Australian history. In 1768, Captain James Cook, departed England on the HMS *Endeavour*, on his first South Pacific voyage. First sighting Point Hicks on 20 April 1770, Cook then sailed north, charting the east coast of Australia. The format of the stamps in this issue is sure to attract plenty of collector interest. The five stamps are each worth \$1.10, and their illustrations present a dual perspective of this historic voyage. Each stamp design is made up of two panes, and each features “Australia” and “55c”. The lower pane includes the year date, and three perforation marks separate the panes. The stamp measures 75mm (h) x 26mm (w).

This edition of the *Bulletin* also presents the stamp products for this year's Australian Legends of Comedy issue, released in April. The two territories issues released over May–June both feature animals, with booby birds on the Cocos (Keeling) Islands stamps and the Norfolk Blue bovine on Norfolk Island. Diverse citizen science programs are recognised in a May issue of four stamps, while at the other end of the cultural scale, Australian fashion photography of the mid-century and Indigenous art from the Western Desert are celebrated in June stamp issues.

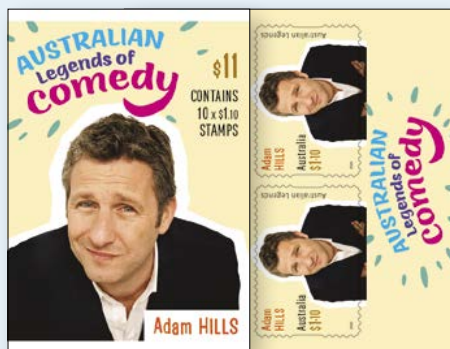
As well as coming to national prominence on our television screens, Adam Hills has toured an impressive 15 solo stand-up comedy shows nationally and internationally, to wide acclaim. Noeline Brown OAM began her five-decade-long career in Sydney's theatre revue scene, before delighting audiences in television skit comedy and variety shows, and on the stage.

Since first appearing on the cult-hit television comedy "The D-Generation" in the 1980s, Magda Szubanski AO has created many much-loved

comic characters, including people-pleasing, accident-prone Sharon Strzelecki in television sitcom "Kath and Kim". Australia has a long tradition of creating satirical characters. One of the most legendary of these was created by Garry McDonald AO. Seemingly-naïve, ambush-style reporter Norman Gunston appeared on our television screens between 1973 and 1993, bewildering unknowing celebrities along the way and leaving audiences in fits of laughter.

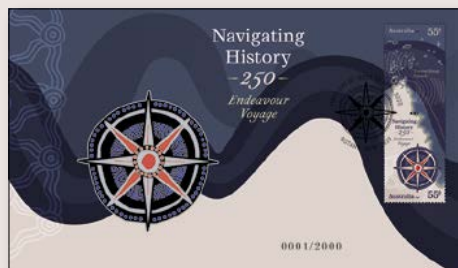
This unusual presentation of five x \$1.10 stamps has the denomination halved and placed as design pairs of 55c. The year of release appears in the bottom half of the stamp design.

The Navigating History stamp issue marks the 250th anniversary of the first Pacific voyage of HMS *Endeavour*, the first recorded ship to make landfall on the east coast of the continent now called Australia. Among those on board were the captain, Lieutenant James Cook, naturalists Joseph Banks and Daniel Solander, and artist Sydney Parkinson.

For several months from April 1770, they charted the east coast, collecting and sketching the flora

and fauna. The continent was subsequently claimed for the British crown on the basis that it was *terra nullius*, or empty land. Of course, this was a fallacy, as Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples had been living on the land for at least 60,000 years.

The gummed first day cover shown opposite features a cut-down of the full stamp design set shown above. Minisheet standing order customers will receive the full design set sheetlet.

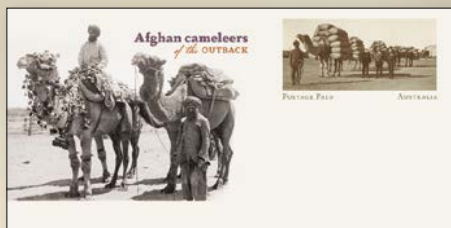
This stamp issue commemorates the *Endeavour's* voyage while recognising that Australia has a much older, rich and continuing Indigenous history at its heart. The stamps are conceived as five vertical pairs, representing the overlapping narratives of the *Endeavour* voyage and Indigenous culture and knowledge. The visual narrative aims to create respect, insight and understanding of the multiple stories, lives and cultures that intersected at the time of the *Endeavour's* first Pacific voyage.

The denomination on the stamps in each pair provides for the \$1.10 base-rate of postage with the pairs presented as semi-imperforate. This is the first such design by Australia Post and it is anticipated that this should be of interest to collectors.

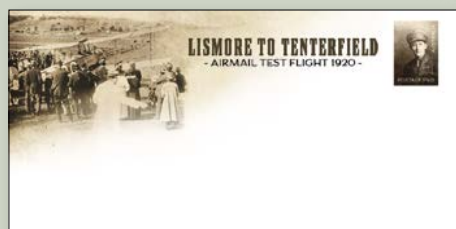

North Keeling Island lies within the Pulu Keeling National Park, and is an important sanctuary for breeding birds, including three species of boobies. These mid to large size seabirds catch fish by undertaking spectacular aerial dives into the ocean, often from considerable heights.

The Brown Booby (*Sula leucogaster plotus*) has a highly distinctive plumage pattern, with chocolate brown upperparts contrasting against white underparts. The Red-footed Booby (*Sula sula rubripes*) is predominantly white, with distinctive red feet, and a pink and blue bill and throat pouch.

The Masked Booby (*Sula dactylatra personata*) is identified by predominantly white plumage with black wings, black tail and dark facial mask.

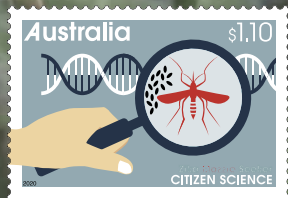

Citizen science involves public participation and collaboration in scientific research. To be involved in citizen science you don't need a science degree.

The Australian Citizen Science Association (ACSA) was formed to advance citizen science through the sharing of knowledge, collaboration, capacity building and advocacy.

The citizen science projects depicted on the stamps were selected by ACSA and show the

diversity of the recent initiatives. Since 2016, the importance of citizen science has been recognised with the Eureka Prize for Innovation in Citizen Science.

QuestaGame (QuestaGame.com) is a gaming application that helps save biodiversity. Players record species while having fun competing and earning rewards. Expert-verified species data is then shared for biodiversity research and conservation.

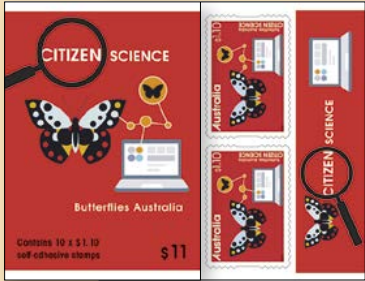

Indigenous people were the first scientists. The **Ngukurr Wi Stadi bla Kantri (We study the Country)** project is a collaboration between the remote Indigenous community of Ngukurr in south east Arnhem Land and Macquarie University to conduct cross-cultural biodiversity research.

The **Butterflies Australia Project** provides citizen scientists with the tools and motivation to record butterfly sightings. The project could lead to better conservation and research of Australia's

butterflies, help protect our agriculture industry, and lead to the discovery of new species.

Most urban areas of Australia are vulnerable to invasions by two Zika mosquito species. Are there Zika mosquitoes in your yard? The **Zika Mozzie Seeker (ZMS)** partnership between Metro South Health and citizen scientists in south-east Queensland hopes to answer this important question.

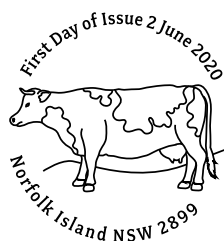

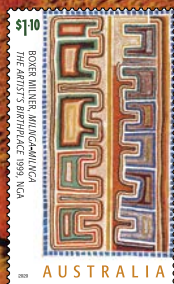

When Norfolk Island was a British penal colony (first in 1788 and then in 1825), the English authorities brought English cattle breeds to the island. When the penal settlements closed, the existing government-owned cattle were left behind for the new settlers, who arrived from Pitcairn Island in 1856. Various efforts were made to prevent the cattle from becoming inbred, including the importation of a blue-coloured Angus-Aberdeen bull. Over time, the cattle began to throw a grey-blue colour, resulting in a unique breed, the Norfolk Blue, which is mid-sized and has a pleasant temperament. This stamp issue presents a Norfolk Blue bull on one stamp, and a cow and calf on the other.

This issue features works by artists from the Western Desert region. Two were associated with the Wirrimanu (Balgo) community in Western Australia and two with the artists' cooperative at Papunya Tula, Northern Territory.

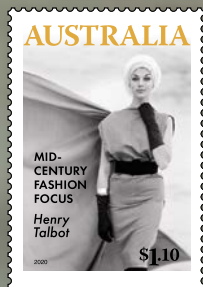
Boxer Milner (c. 1935–2009) was a senior lawman and custodian of the Purkitjii (Sturt Creek) area. *Milnga-Milnga* relates to the Sturt Creek flood plain between the Great Sandy Desert and the Tanami Desert. Eubena Nampitjin (c. 1925–2013) was a law woman and artist in the Balgo

community. Her art focused on her homelands around Tjintalpa.

Walter Tjampitjinpa (c. 1912–81) was a founder of the Papunya art movement. A senior man and ceremonial leader he was custodian of the Water Dreaming that runs through Kalipimpinpa. Fred Ward Tjungurrayi (c. 1948–) was born at Purkitjarra, east of Kiwirrkura in the Western Desert. He painted with Papunya Tula Artists in the 1980s and works with Kayili Artists at Patjarr.

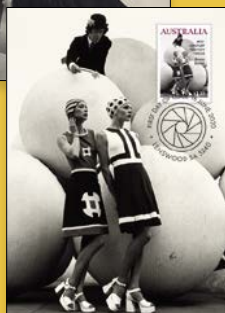

Following World War II, economic and social changes invigorated the Australian fashion industry, and made the latest styles accessible to a youthful and increasingly independent generation. Photography was the perfect medium to serve the expanding fashion market, where it was primarily used to sell clothes.

Melbourne was at the heart of Australian fashion, and a natural home for the nascent field of fashion photography. It was also where masters of the

medium, Athol Shmith (1914–90), Helmut Newton (1920–2004), Henry Talbot (1920–99) and Bruno Benini (1925–2001) established their careers.

The design of this stamp issue returns four remarkable photographs to their original commercial context by evoking magazine cover art. The use of bold typography, overprinting and distinctive typefaces are a clear nod to the design tradition of fashion magazines.
