# Hello Collectors

Welcome to another edition of the *Stamp Bulletin*, where we showcase new Australian stamp issues and collectables. We're proud to present a stamp issue that recognises workers on the frontline of the Covid-19 pandemic (as mentioned in our previous edition). The efforts of these "frontline heroes" cannot be underestimated.

In late February, the Ramsar Wetlands commemorative international stamp designs highlight the beauty and diversity of Australian wetlands, which play an important role in environmental and human health.

There are two single stamp releases in March. Edith Cowan OBE, a long-standing social justice advocate, achieved a remarkable feat by being the first woman elected to any parliament in Australia. We also commemorate the arrival of HMVS *Cerberus* in Port Phillip Bay, 150 years ago. The ship was commissioned as a coastal defence to safeguard the City of Melbourne.

Also in March, we celebrate the Australian Legends of Cricket – six of our finest living players, past and present. The stamps are presented in three se-tenant pairs and feature the players in action, using the on-field skills that have made them household names. We look back at some much-loved Holden car models, including "Australia's Own Car": the 1948 Holden 48-215 or "FX", in the wake of the retirement of this iconic brand.

In April, we commemorate 100 years of Rotary in Australia, Rotary being one of the largest service organisations in the world. We also present Lest We Forget, in the lead-up to Anzac Day. The issue highlights the Anzac Day traditions of wreath-laying and poetry reading and includes two postal numismatic covers.

I'm also excited to provide collectors with the opportunity to obtain Australia Post's exclusive version of the popular board game Monopoly at a great discount price. Details of how to pre-order your copy, while stocks last, and using the pre-order code supplied, are on page 31. I think collectors will enjoy the inclusion of Stamp Archives on the board.

Wetlands are vital to environmental and human health. These highly productive ecosystems sustain biological diversity, provide flora and fauna habitat, improve water quality, replenish groundwater, store carbon, protect against erosion and regulate flood peaks and storm surges. They also enhance our lives through being places of recreation, education, tourism and natural beauty. For Indigenous Australians, they also connect meaningfully to country and culture.

This stamp issue commemorates the Ramsar Convention on Wetlands of International Importance, signed on 2 February 1971, and of which Australia is a co-founder. The convention recognises important wetlands around the globe, and seeks to halt wetland loss of through the wise use and management of this precious resource. Australia is home to the first designated Ramsar wetland: the Cobourgh Peninsula wetland, listed in 1974. The other three sites depicted in the stamps illustrate some of the diversity of Ramsar-designated wetlands in Australia.

Edith Dircksey Cowan OBE (1861–1932), a long-time social justice campaigner, was part of a push for greater civic rights for women, following World War I. In 1920, legislation was finally passed that ended the legal barrier to women serving in the Western Australian Parliament.

Cowan was one of four women candidates in the 1921 Western Australian election. During the campaign, Cowan highlighted her significant community service record, for which she was awarded an OBE in 1920.

At 59 years of age, she narrowly defeated the West Perth sitting member to not only become the first woman in the Western Australian Parliament but also in any parliament in Australia.

Cowan was a forceful and effective parliamentarian. She advocated for social change, particularly for women and children, succeeding in the rare feat of having two private member's bills passed. While Cowan lost the 1924 and 1927 elections, she had already become a trailblazer for women.





Since 1984, the Australian Antarctic Arts Fellowship program has enabled artists and writers to travel to Antarctica and create work inspired by their experiences and insights. The program seeks to increase awareness and appreciation of Antarctica and the subantarctic, including its unique environment and rich history. Through their Antarctic-inspired creations, fellows have done much to promote the icy continent and the work of the Australian Antarctic Program to Australians and the world. The annual fellowships are made

possible by the Australian Antarctic Division with support from ANAT, an Australian organisation that creates opportunities for artists to work with art, science and technology partners. The fellowships are awarded via a national application and selection process, which opens annually in March.





It is 150 years since HMVS *Cerberus* arrived in Port Phillip Bay, on 9 April 1871. The British-built *Cerberus* was commissioned as a coastal defence ship to safeguard Melbourne, the Australian colonies' largest and wealthiest city in the late 19th century. The small and unconventional-looking vessel was once our most powerful warship and notable for her place in the evolution of warship design; this breastwork monitor was iron clad and steam powered, with raised revolving gun turrets on a central superstructure and with a low freeboard.

For more than three decades, the *Cerberus* presided over Port Phillip Bay. During this long career she was not once called upon to engage in conflict, so had no cause to fire a single shot in combat.

The stamp shows the *Cerberus* on the waters of Port Phillip Bay painted in her fourth colour scheme, introduced in 1888.

When the Holden 48-215 sedan rolled off the production line in 1948, the first car wholly manufactured in Australia, it was an instant hit with the public. The production of "Australia's Own Car", which became known as the "FX", boosted national pride and made the Holden brand a household name. Holden ended its Australian manufacturing operations on 20 October 2017, after constructing more than 7.6 million vehicles for Australia and the world. In February 2020 it

was announced that the Holden brand would be retired by 2021 and enter a new era as a certified service and parts provider to the 1.6 million Holdens still on the road. This stamp issue takes a nostalgic look back at some iconic Holden car models, including the luxurious 1963 EH Premier; the fast and flashy 1968 HK Monaro GT327; the 1971 HQ Kingswood Ute, a favourite of farmers and tradies; and the 2006 VE Commodore SS V, from the highest-selling Holden car model series.

leading lights in the fields of medical science, philanthropy, fashion design, tennis and children's literature.



In 1877, an Australian team played England at the Melbourne Cricket Ground in what would later be recognised as

the first Test match. Organised women's cricket has been played in Australia since the late 19th century, and the first women's Test match was played against England in Brisbane in 1934. Cricket continues to be a national obsession and our most popular participation sport. More than a million Australians play formal, organised cricket every year and televised cricket is a familiar backdrop to our sultry Australian summers.





Wreath-laying and poetry readings are important components of annual Anzac Day commemorations in Australia. While single poppies aren't usually worn on Anzac Day, wreaths of poppies are traditionally placed at memorials. In 1934, Prince Henry, Duke of Gloucester, planted a pine tree in the grounds of the Australian War Memorial, which was still under construction. Nearby, he placed a poppy wreath, which is featured on the stamp.

Laurel (bay) leaves woven into a wreath is another prominent commemorative symbol on Anzac Day. The wreath's traditional tear-shape symbolises tears shed for the dead, and in Roman times laurel was used to crown victors and the brave. A collection of three poppies is often included at the base of the wreath, representing each of the Australian armed services (Army, Navy and Air Force). Sometimes rosemary is incorporated, another symbol of remembrance, and a purple "Lest We Forget" ribbon draped across, purple being associated with mourning.




