# Hello Collectors

Welcome to another edition of the *Stamp Bulletin*, which presents upcoming Australian stamp issues for September and October. Included is a stamp issue to mark the end of the Holden era in motorsport. A fleet of Holdens is expected to compete in a final Bathurst 1000, in 2021.

We mark the centenary of the iconic Australian comic strip character Ginger Meggs, who was originally known as Ginger Smith, when he made his debut in 1921. The mischievous red-headed boy continues to delight fans in Australia and around the world.

We also mark 100 years since the establishment of Australia's first regular airmail service, only a decade after Australia's first aeroplane flight. In 1921, the government put out its first tender for a subsidised mail and limited passenger service, which operated in north-west Western Australia.

Our Centenary of the Archibald Prize stamp issue celebrates this renowned award for portraiture, by showcasing three winning portraits from across the decades, including one of the most universally recognised – a portrait of artist Albert Namatjira by celebrated Australian portrait painter William Dargie.

We recognise the important work of the RSCPA, which has been undertaking and promoting the care and protection of animals for 150 years.

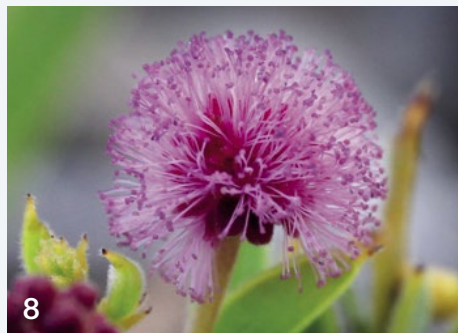
We also mark Her Majesty The Queen's 95th birthday, with a release that has been timed to coincide more closely with the official celebration of this milestone in Western Australia (end of September) and Queensland (early October).

There are four new stamp releases that focus on themes from our natural world. Wattle Wonders showcases wattle flowers that bloom in colours other than yellow, the most typical. We present some of the oldest living organisms on Earth, through AAT: Lichen. Norfolk Island's two endemic butterfly subspecies are showcased, and we highlight three Australian animals that have mastered the art of camouflage.

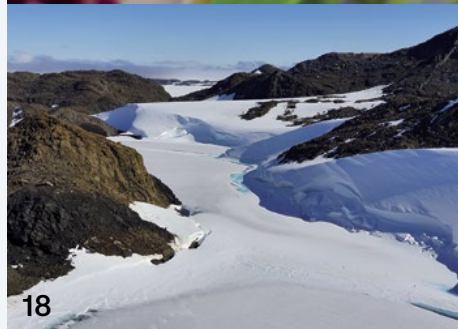

This stamp issue celebrates the centenary of a distinctive and ever-youthful Australian character; in 2021, Ginger Meggs turns 100. He made his debut on the comic scene in November 1921, a side character named Ginger Smith to comic lead Gladstone Gladys, in a comic strip that initially took her name. Over the months that followed he morphed into leading character Ginger Meggs, the much-loved mischievous, red-headed rascal who is still recognisably Australian in today's globalised world.

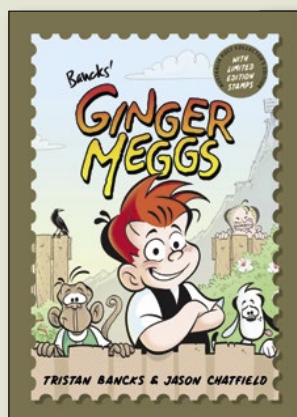
James Charles "Jimmy" Bancks created Ginger for the strip that was soon renamed "Us Fellers" and published each Sunday in the "Sunbeams" section of Sydney's *Sun*, also appearing in the *Sun News-Pictorial* in Melbourne. Such was young Ginge's popularity that in 1939 "Us Fellers" was renamed "Ginger Meggs", by which time Bancks had already syndicated the comic strip widely. As well as appearing in a weekly strip, from 1924 until 1959 (with the exception of 1952), Ginge was also the star of the annual *Sunbeams Book: More Adventures of Ginger Meggs*.

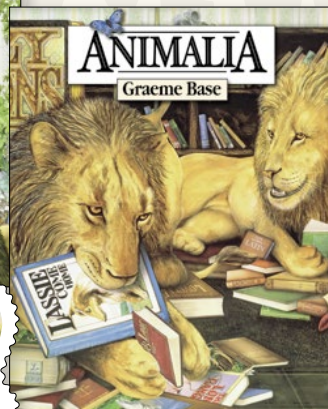
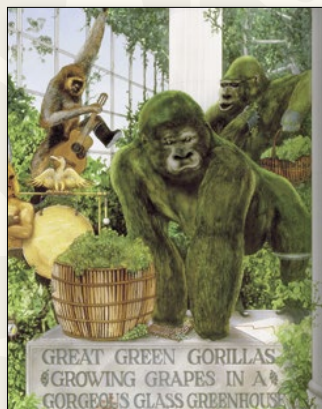

From early on, Ginge was joined in his suburban escapades by a muff-wearing girlfriend named Minnie Peters (who evolved from the earlier character Gladsome Gladys), mates Benny and Ocker, and faithful companions Mike the dog and Tony the monkey. Character-driven, the comic has always appealed to its young and adult readers as much for its narrative bent and comic wit as for its illustrations. It has also been persistently tuned to the events, preoccupations and tone of its time, capturing a distinctly Australian spirit and vernacular.

When Bancks died unexpectedly in 1952, his comic creation lived on. The pen was taken up by Ron Vivian, who crafted "Ginger Meggs" until 1973. Since then, the adventures of the red-headed rascal have been devised and illustrated by Lloyd Piper (1973–83), James Kemsley (1983–2007) and, since 2007, Jason Chatfield. The stamps in this issue show illustrations from across the esteemed life of Ginger, by originator Jimmy Bancks and more recent cartoonists James Kemsley and Jason Chatfield.

From internationally acclaimed Australian author/illustrator, Graeme Base, *Animalia* continues to be a favourite children's picture book. Published in 1986, this was the author's second book.

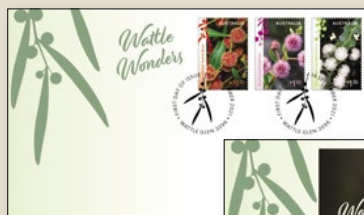

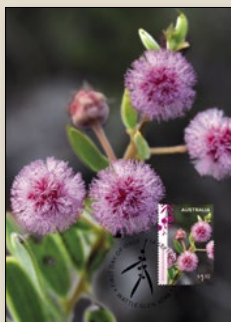

In the lead up to Federation (1901), Australian native plants increased in popularity, especially as people went in search of uniquely Australian motifs and national symbols. *Acacia* species, commonly known as wattle and widely distributed across Australia, soon became seen as symbol of patriotism. Wattle was essentially adopted as a national flower, when a stylised wattle was incorporated into the second design of the Commonwealth Coat of Arms, which received royal assent in 1912. While Golden Wattle (*Acacia pycnantha*) enjoyed popular acceptance as Australia's national flower for much of the 20th century, it was not officially proclaimed as the national floral

emblem until 1988, the year of Australia's bicentenary. In 1992, 1 September (the first day of spring) was formally proclaimed as National Wattle Day.


While the flowers of most wattle species are yellow or golden, there are some exceptions, including those featured in this stamp issue: a remarkable, red-flowered form of Cinnamon Wattle (*Acacia leprosa*); the only Australian wattle with purple flowers, the endangered *Acacia purpureopetala*; and *Acacia alata* var. *biglandulosa*, commonly known as Winged Wattle and so named for its unusual flat and continuous wing-like foliage.

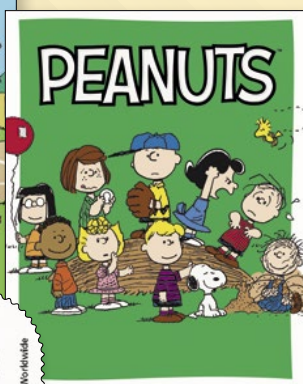

This issue commemorates the 95th birthday of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. Monarch of the United Kingdom and 15 other Commonwealth realms, Her Majesty was born on 21 April 1926 at the home of her maternal grandparents in Mayfair, London. She acceded to the throne on 6 February 1952 and is now both the longest living and longest reigning monarch in British history.

This year's international post stamp features a 2020 portrait of the Queen with her heirs: Charles, Prince of Wales; Prince William, Duke of Cambridge; and

Prince George of Cambridge. The photograph on the domestic stamp was taken in November 2019 during Her Majesty's visit to the new headquarters of the Royal Philatelic Society in London, which was first established in 1869. The royal family has enjoyed a long association with philately. As Patron of the Royal Philatelic Society, Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II continues her family's interest in philately, graciously allowing a selection from The Royal Philatelic Collection to be displayed at the society's opening meeting each season.



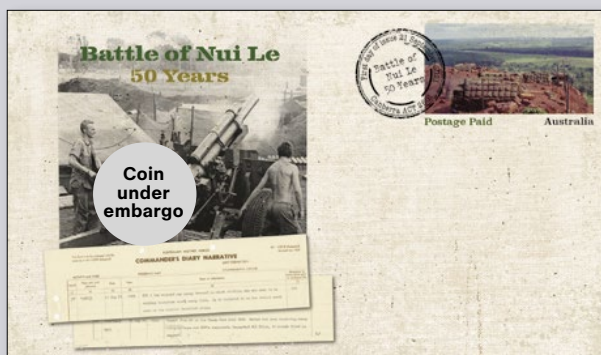
# Battle of Nui Le: 50 Years

Much of Norfolk's invertebrate fauna is yet to be comprehensively investigated and documented, but 17 species of butterfly have been observed, with two not seen for more than a century. Of the remaining 15, two of these are endemic subspecies: they are the Norfolk Swallowtail (*Papilio amyntor amphiarus*) and Norfolk Island Gull (*Cepora perimale perimale*).

The elegant Norfolk Swallowtail belongs to the family Papilionidae and is fairly common on the island. The much smaller Norfolk Island Gull is the territory's subspecies of *C. perimale*, belonging to the family Pieridae. While the subspecies is endemic to Norfolk, the species is found elsewhere. Its host plant is *Capparis nobilis*, known as Devil's Guts. The stamp shows a female individual and the minisheet a male, which explains the colour differentiation.

In celebration of 100 years of Australia's oldest and best loved portrait award, the Archibald Prize at the Art Gallery of New South Wales, this issue features three unforgettable Archibald Prize-winning portraits from across the decades. The earliest is the 1948 winning portrait of artist Margaret Olley (1923–2011) by William Dobell (1899–1970), one of his finest works and an enduring favourite in the Art Gallery's collection. The 1956 winning portrait of Western Arrernte artist Albert Namatjira (1902–59) by celebrated

Australian portrait painter, William Dargie (1912–2003), is one of the most recognisable and universally respected of all Archibald winners. In 2013, the prize was awarded to a portrait of one of Australia's most acclaimed actors, Hugo Weaving (1960–), by Del Kathryn Barton (1972–), who is renowned for decorative, highly detailed paintings with vibrant, figurative imagery. This Archibald centenary year also marks the 150th anniversary of the Art Gallery of New South Wales, one of the nation's major cultural institutions.

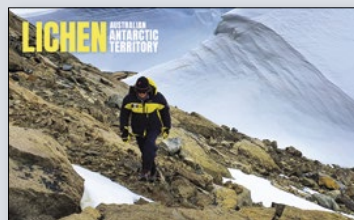
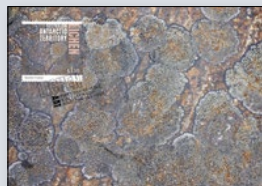

Lichen is a plant comprising layers of both fungi and green algae. It forms because of the symbiotic relationship between the two; fungi are dependent on algae for photosynthesis and algae on fungi for protection. Lichens are some of the oldest living organisms on Earth and possess several adaptations that enable them to survive in harsh Antarctic conditions.

The lichen *Xanthoria mawsonii* grows in the coastal regions of Antarctic and is very visible due to its wonderfully bright orange-red colour. *Xanthoria*

*elegans* is known as the “elegant sunburst” lichen. Like *mawsonii*, it grows on rocks near bird colonies where it relies on nutrients from bird droppings. *Buellia frigida* is a very tough lichen and the most abundant lichen in the Australian Antarctic Territory (AAT). It relies on snowmelt for growth. While very fragile, *Umbilicaria decussata* is one of the tallest lichens in the AAT, growing up to 10 millimetres in height. Its structure allows for entrapment of soil, dust and guano particles which are accessed to aid growth.

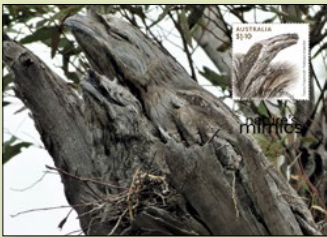

The natural world is remarkable for its capacity to adapt and evolve, to function as a finely tuned model of interrelation. Thousands of organisms – animal and plant, though most numerously in the insect world – employ modes of deception for this purpose. They prolong their lives through protective and/or predatory disguises that increase their defences, their access to food and the likelihood of their successful reproduction. Part of natural selection, mimicry confers advantage to a mimetic species in the ongoing battle for survival.

Mimicry is not only a visual or perceptual mechanism, resemblance effected through colouration, texture and even morphology; it extends through behaviours such as vocalisation, particularly evident in birds, performance, and scent or pheromone release, with the mimic's intention being to alter the behaviour of the receiver. The stamps show animals from three groups – a bird, a fish and an insect – that use visual mimicry to camouflage themselves for defensive purposes.

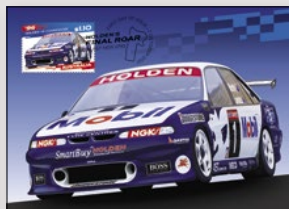

Holden cars are synonymous with success on the racetrack, from the first known Holden racing victory, in the Experts Trial, Victoria, in 1951, right through to victory in the 2020 Bathurst 1000. Written into the record books are 21 Australian Touring Car/Supercars Championship victories and 34 Holden victories in the Bathurst 1000 (originally the Bathurst 500), with Holden expected to take its final roar around the Bathurst track in 2021.

Holden captured the attention of the Australian youth market with the release of its Torana models

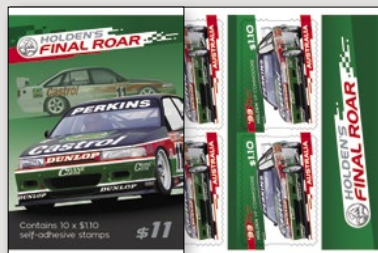
in the late 1960s and early 1970s. They were small bodied but powerful cars and one of them, the LJ Torana XU-1, was driven by Peter Brock to his first win at Bathurst in 1972, the first of five Bathurst wins for the Torana in the 1970s.

Larry Perkins' victory with Gregg Hansford in the 1993 Bathurst 1000 was built upon speed and engineering know-how. Unlike his fellow Commodore drivers, Perkins opted to stick with Holden's trusty five-litre V8 engine rather than move to Chevrolet-based units like his main rivals.

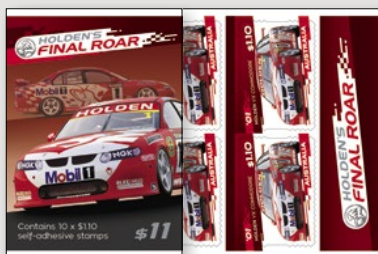

The 1996 Holden VR Commodore propelled driver Craig Lowndes, then aged 21, to become the youngest-ever winner of the Australian Touring Car Championship (ATCC) and the youngest driver at the time to win at Bathurst. Lowndes became just the second driver to win the touring car trifecta of the ATCC, Sandown and Bathurst in the same season.

The Holden Commodore VX that debuted in 2001 was so successful and so loved by its driver Mark Skaife that it was nicknamed "The Golden Child".

It won Bathurst in Skaife's hands in both 2001 and 2002, making it just the second individual car to win multiple Bathurst 1000 races.

The last Bathurst race with Holden factory support was in 2020, won by Shane van Gisbergen and Garth Tander's ZB Commodore. A fleet of ZB Commodores is expected to be the last Holdens to compete in the Bathurst 1000, in 2021 – a swan song for the electrifying and dominant force that has been Holden in Australian motorsport.

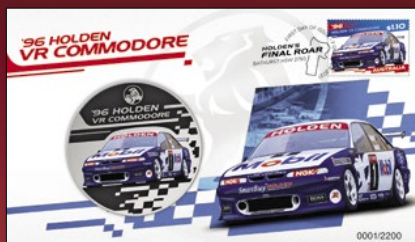

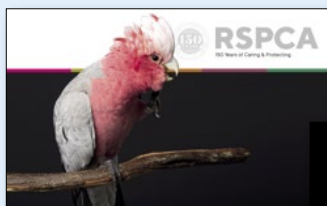

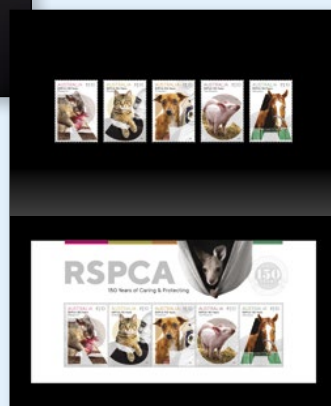

In 2021, it is 150 years since the first Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals opened its doors in Australia. Now known as the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (RSPCA), this venerable organisation traces its roots to a public meeting held in Melbourne on 4 July 1871 to discuss the ill treatment of horses in Victoria – horses being, at a time, essential for the transportation of people and goods in the colony.

Following the society's establishment in Victoria, other Australian colonies followed suit over

the next two decades, with New South Wales founding its society in 1873, South Australia in 1875, Tasmania in 1878, Queensland in 1883 and Western Australia in 1892. The Australian Capital Territory and Northern Territory formed their societies in the mid-20th century, in 1955 and 1965 respectively.

The focus of the RSPCA's work has broadened and changed since its beginning, to reflect the shifting historical landscape and our relationship to animals. Yet, some 150 years since its

formation, the RSPCA maintains its founding vision of encouraging and compelling ethical, humane and responsible practices in our varied interactions with animals.

The stamps in this issue have been designed to represent five key aspects of the RSPCA's mission and work: research, shelter, protection, certification and advocacy. These varied aspects do not work in isolation but are integrally linked and most often they inform one another in safeguarding animal welfare. For example, without

science-based research it would be impossible to deliver the certified Approved Farming Scheme, which benefits the lives of many individual animals within a viable commercial context, and similarly research informs the shelter and release of injured native wildlife that has come into the care of a member society. Together, the five stamps also indicate the breadth of the RSPCA's work across the domains of companion animals and pets; livestock; animals in sport, recreation and industry; and wildlife.

In the early years of the 20th century, aviation was an embryonic technology, with the first flight taking place in Australia in 1910. Merely a decade later, and following the hostilities World War I, the federal government saw the potential for civil and commercial aviation in a country as large and sparsely populated as ours. In May 1921, government called for tenders for Australia's first subsidised airmail and limited passenger service, which would operate in north-west Western Australia. Perth-raised aviator and businessman

Norman Brearley, who'd flown during the war, bid successfully. He founded Western Australian Airways (WAA) to fly weekly between Geraldton and Derby, stopping at Carnarvon, Onslow, Roebourne, Port Hedland and Broome. Previously, mail had travelled by steamer on a monthly service that took around two weeks. After a devastating start on 5 December 1921, with one of the Bristol Tourers crash-landing north of Geraldton, a minor service to Port Hedland began on 22 February 1922 before the full air service restarted on 6 April.
