

#### **Hello Collectors**

Welcome to the first edition of the *Stamp Bulletin* for the New Year, which provides a preview of the stamps and collectables that will be released during January and February 2022.

Lunar New Year of the Tiger will be the first stamp issue of 2022. The stamp designs are based on the traditional beckoning Lucky Cat figurine, which is a symbol of good fortune and prosperity. The collectables from this issue are perfect for gift-giving or as a keepsake. Some, such as the postcard, postage paid envelopes and stamp pack, can be used as a very special New Year greeting.

Under Sail, as its name suggests, showcases the sport of sailing. The photographs feature three types of vessels on the open sea, highlighting the exhilaration and athleticism that are central to this popular pastime.

Our first Norfolk Island stamp issue for the year presents segments of two delightful watercolours by artist John Eyre (1771–?), which date from the early 19th century.

In 2022 we commemorate 50 years since Australia became the first country worldwide to legislate for compulsory seatbelt wearing in front and back seats. The law was designed to reduce the number of fatalities and life-changing injuries on Australian roads and is a timely reminder to remember to "buckle up".

Our Beautiful Continent presents three exceptional and remarkable Australian landscapes from the UNESCO World Heritage list and another recently included on the World Heritage Tentative List: the Greater Blue Mountains Area, the Flinders Ranges, the Ningaloo Coast and the Gondwana Rainforests.

This edition also previews the latest in our Special Occasions stamp series, which provides versatile stamp designs for a variety of celebratory and social greetings. We provide details of our plans for celebrating gold medal performances by Australian athletes that occur at the Winter Olympic Games in Beijing, and we introduce the new International Reply Coupon design for those interested in this useful postage payment option.

Lunar New Year, also called the Spring Festival in China, is the most important of the traditional festivals celebrated by Asian cultures throughout the world. It is a time to complete unfinished business and settle debts to begin the New Year with a clean slate. Celebrations include congregating with relatives and friends for feasts and to exchange gifts of money wrapped in lucky red paper. Incense is burned to honour ancestors.

The Year of the Tiger begins on 1 February 2022. The third animal in the 12-year cycle, the Tiger is a born leader, brave, competitive and confident.

Those born under this sign tend to be very active, courageous, persistent, stubborn and imperious, with a tendency to irritability. In Chinese culture, Tigers are regarded as the guardians of children, and infants wear shoes and hats with tiger designs to protect against evil spirits.

The stamp designs are based on the Asian tradition of the beckoning Lucky Cat figurine. These symbols of good fortune, wealth and prosperity originated in Japan, where they are known as *maneki-neko*. Colourful Lucky Cat figurines are a common sight at the entrance to small Asian businesses.





International Reply Coupons are available from participating post offices.














Sailing is popular in ocean-loving Australia, where towns and cities punctuate the 34,000 kilometres of stunning coastline. Today's wind-powered watercraft largely belong to the realms of sport and leisure, and sail-boat racing has long had a foothold in Australia. The first yachting clubs were established here in the mid-19th century, and now more than 360 yacht clubs around Australia support sailing culture. On weekends fleets of watercraft can be regularly seen in regattas and club races.

The stamps in this issue depict three types of watercraft and show the skill and athleticism required of their crew. The first shows a supermaxi surging through the water during the annual Sydney Hobart Yacht Race; the second, a Nacra 15 catamaran on a day of high wind during the Australian Sailing Youth Championships; and the third, a 16-foot skiff, with the crew using the trapeze to counter-balance the pressure of a strong southerly on Lake Macquarie.

# Norfolk Island Historical Views

Released 19 January 2022






Artist John Eyre (1771–?) never visited Norfolk Island. His charming watercolours featured in this stamp issue (depicting Queenborough, now Longview, and Sydney, now Kingston) make use of earlier drawings by Norfolk Island storekeeper, and later deputy commissioner, William Neate Chapman (1773?–1838).

Eyre was born at Coventry, England, where he became an apprentice weaver. In 1799 he was sentenced to seven years for housebreaking and transported to New South Wales. Following a conditional pardon in 1804, Eyre purchased a box of watercolours and began taking commissions, including for Governor William Bligh and drawings for Absalom West, who published a series of engraved Sydney scenes. It is believed that Eyre left for Europe in 1812, after which time little is known. His original works can be found in the British Museum, the State Library of New South Wales and the National Library of Australia.














Today, it's hard to imagine seatbelts not being standard in cars and most other road vehicles, and it's second nature to most of us to buckle up before pulling onto the bitumen. But it was a long, slow journey to achieve what now seems an obvious measure towards road safety.


On 1 January 1972, Australia became the first country in the world to legislate for compulsory seatbelt wearing in front and back seats, and this issue marks the 50th anniversary of that milestone. Road-user behaviour is among state

and territory responsibilities, and Victoria led the way in passing seatbelt legislation on 22 December 1970. This came after a decade of research, standards development, campaigning and public education, and also despite a level of opposition right to the end. Victoria proved a catalyst for change, and New South Wales passed its legislation on 1 October 1971. Within another three months, the other states and territories had come onboard, and by 1 January 1972 seatbelt wearing was compulsory across Australia.








This issue features landscapes from three UNESCO World Heritage properties and another recently included on the World Heritage Tentative List. The Greater Blue Mountains Area (inscribed 2000) is a biodiverse region of sandstone plateaux, escarpments and gorges dominated by temperate eucalypt forest. The Flinders Ranges (inscribed 2011) is a semi-arid mountainous landscape. It features diverse landscapes, rich biodiversity and an exceptional geological record of the dawn of animal life on Earth. The Ningaloo Coast (inscribed

2011) supports exceptional biodiversity of marine and terrestrial life and is one of the longest near-shore reefs in the world with an extensive karst system and network of underground caves and water courses. The Gondwana Rainforests (first inscribed 1986) includes important volcanic features and it supports the most extensive subtropical rainforest in the world. It is the principal habitat for many rare and threatened rainforest species, some with origins in the ancient supercontinent Gondwana.




