Hello Collectors

Welcome to a new edition of the *Stamp Bulletin*, presenting upcoming Australian and territories stamp issues, as well as themed collectables.

In March, we celebrate 150 years of sheepdog trials in Australia, which are still held today in most states and territories. The stamp designs showcase iconic Australian dog breeds (the Kelpie and Border Collie) that use their intelligence and agility to corral sheep through a course.

On 15 March, we'll announce the 2022 recipients of the Australia Post Australian Legends Award. The Legends and stamp designs will be showcased in the next edition. In the meantime, on page 27, we've listed the collectables that will be released with the stamp issue.

Also released in March will be an issue of four stamps presenting two species of penguin that live and breed in the Australian Antarctic Territory, the Adélie Penguin and Emperor Penguin.

In April, we commemorate an incredible milestone: the Platinum Jubilee of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. The Queen remains the longest-reigning living monarch and becomes the only British monarch to have reigned for seven decades. The Queen is also celebrating her 96th birthday. Collectables include a medallion cover that features the official Platinum Jubilee emblem.


Later in April, we look back on the integral role that postcards played in keeping soldiers on the frontline, during WWI, in contact with their loved ones at home. We also celebrate the centenary of the Country Women's Association in Australia and recognise the integral role this organisation plays in rural and remote communities.



Australia supports a population of around 64 million sheep and lambs, and is one of the highest wool, lamb and mutton producers in the world. Sheepdogs have long been integral to the management of flocks of sheep, gathering the sheep in large paddocks, binding the animals together by weaving side-to-side at their backs then driving the group forward. A single sheepdog can herd flocks of numerous unruly sheep.


Sheepdog trials have been conducted in Australia for approximately 150 years. In Australia, sheepdogs are predominantly Kelpies or Border Collies, both exceptionally intelligent, agile, and obedient breeds, with great stamina for hard work. Kelpies are medium-sized dogs, first bred near Casterton, Victoria, in the late 19th century. Coat colours include black, red, blue and fawn and coat types can be short, smooth and rough. The Border Collie evolved on the Scottish border with England



and was bred as a working dog in Australia in the early 20th century. The long, dense double coat is most commonly black-and-white, but other colours include blue-and-white and brown-and-white. Today, these two breeds are among the 270,000 stock-herding dogs that contribute to the economy of rural Australia.

By the 1880s, sheepdog trials were becoming a popular sport at many agricultural shows across the nation. In the events of this competitive sport, one or two dogs move three to six sheep around

a paddock, fences, gates, yards or enclosures according to a handler's instructions. The dogs are judged on obedience and speed, and the competitor is penalised if the sheep deviate from the prescribed course. Separating sheep is particularly difficult for the dogs, as herd animals naturally resist being split into groups. Sheepdog trials are held in most states and territories and since 1943 the National Sheep Dog Trial Championships have been held annually in Canberra.





Two of the world's 18 penguin species live and breed in the Australian Antarctic Territory (AAT). The medium-size Adélie Penguin (*Pygoscelis adeliae*) breeds annually between October and February at ice-free sites around the coastline. Two eggs are laid in a nest made of pebbles and are incubated in turn by both parents. The largest and tallest of all penguin species, the Emperor Penguin (*Aptenodytes forsteri*) can weigh up to 40 kilograms. Emperor Penguins

typically breed on fast-ice near the coastline and are the only penguins to breed in the Antarctic winter. They are adapted to the extreme cold and wind, with several layers of feathers, large reserves of fat and small beaks and flippers to minimise heat loss. One egg is laid in May or early June. Shown on the minisheet, the Chinstrap Penguin (*Pygoscelis antarctica*), a rare visitor to the AAT, breeds on sub-Antarctic islands and the most northern tip of Antarctica.



This year, 2022, marks the Platinum Jubilee of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. Princess Elizabeth became Queen of the United Kingdom and the Commonwealth at age 25, upon the death of her father, George VI, on 6 February 1952. Born on 21 April 1926, the Queen also celebrates her 96th birthday this year. After a remarkable 70 years on the throne, the Queen remains the longest-reigning living monarch and becomes the only British monarch to have ruled for seven decades.

Many events are planned to mark this historic jubilee around the Commonwealth, including a four-day weekend of celebrations in the United Kingdom. The Federal Government recently announced that jubilee beacons will be lit, and a special event will be held in Canberra, in June, at which the new Queen Elizabeth Water Gardens will be dedicated and Aspen Island, in Lake Burley Griffin, will be renamed Queen Elizabeth II Island.

This year's stamp designs emphasise the colour platinum and include a graphic rendition of St Edward's Crown, which forms part of the Queen's cypher. The domestic-rate stamp features a photograph by Dorothy Wilding (1893–1976), the first woman to be appointed as official royal photographer. It forms part of the collections of the National Portrait Gallery, London. Hand-coloured by Beatrice Johnson (1906–2000), the photograph was taken on 15 April 1952 as part of a series that commenced

on 26 February 1952, just weeks into the Queen's reign. Its central purpose was to assist with creating the likeness of Her Majesty on new coins, banknotes and stamps, including in Australia. In the photograph, the Queen is wearing the Diamond Diadem, which was commissioned for George IV's coronation in 1821 and is set with 1,333 diamonds. The international-rate stamp features a photograph of the Queen attending an event to mark the centenary of British Airways, in 1919.

Beijing 2022 Winter Olympics gold medallist sheetlets



The Beijing 2022 Winter Olympics will open on 4 February 2022. Australia Post will celebrate all Australian gold medal performances with a gold medallist sheetlet.

Australia Post will produce a sheetlet of gold medallist stamps after the medal ceremony takes place.*

Purchase through participating Australian Post Offices, the Australian Philatelic Bureau and online after a gold medal ceremony.*

Gold medallist instant sheetlets are not included with any Philatelic Bureau standing order. If you have a standing order you will need to order your gold medallist sheetlets separately from the Philatelic Bureau.

*Availability will depend on the gold medal ceremony timing. Gold medal achievements unknown at time of printing. Individual stamps not available, only full gold medallist sheetlets of 10 stamps.



During World War I (1914–18), postcards were perfect for regular messages of love and encouragement to the tens of thousands of individuals serving abroad. Equally, these humble postal items were sent home from distant theatres of conflict.

Postcards may have been produced as a cheap and convenient form of communication, but these unassuming missives are also instructive for their recollection of wartime – through both their heartfelt and often matter-of-fact messages and

their printed matter. This stamp issue focuses on postcards sent from Australia to those serving abroad. The stamps feature postcards of the iconic Laughing Kookaburra, and represent the naval, infantry and air services through the birds' hats. The clever anthropomorphism suggests the larrikin nature of Australians, embraced since the war as part of the Anzac spirit.

This stamp issue is accompanied by a PNC marking the 80th anniversary of the Kokoda Trail Campaign, fought during World War II.



The Country Women's Association (CWA) is a collection of state- and territory-based associations, each of which is apolitical, non-sectarian and not-for-profit, and seeks to improve conditions for country women, as well as children, families and communities. This is achieved through advocacy, community work, fundraising (including through the sale of its famous scones) and creating a support and social network for women, particularly in remote areas.

The first association, the CWA of New South Wales, formed 100 years ago in April 1922, and Grace Munro MBE became its first president. An association was formed in Queensland in August of that year. The remaining states and territories established branches or associations by 1946 – each guided by the long-standing motto “Service to the Country, Through Country Women, For Country Women, By Country Women”.


