Welcome to the latest edition of the *Stamp Bulletin*, presenting new stamp issues for Australia and Australian Territories.

In July, we commemorate the 50th anniversary of the knighting of Pastor Sir Douglas Nicholls KCVO OBE, a tireless advocate and the first Aboriginal Australian to receive this high honour.

We also mark the centenary of the Australian men's national football team, now known as the "Socceroos".

Also in July, we'll release a three-stamp issue featuring Australia's iconic Budgerigar, or Budgie. This colourful and clever small parrot is one of the world's most popular pets.

In August, we commemorate the 75th anniversary of the establishment of Australia's Antarctic research program, which facilitates diverse and important scientific research into the icy continent.

We also look back on the completion of the Overland Telegraph line, connecting Adelaide and Darwin, 150 years ago. This line transformed communications across the country as well as between Australia and the rest of the world.

Also in August, we feature an insect whose call is synonymous with Australian summer, the cicada. There are roughly 1,000 species of cicada native to Australia, which is the greatest diversity of this group of insects in the world.

We also celebrate the achievements of the recently announced Australian Paralympians of the Year, with two special sheetlets of stamps. See page 31 for details.





Yorta Yorta man Pastor Sir Douglas (Doug) Ralph Nicholls (1906–88) was a footballer, pastor, Aboriginal rights campaigner, community leader and state governor. Throughout his adult life, his deep compassion and consummate skills in advocacy and negotiation drove his commitment to addressing issues of social justice for Aboriginal people.

This single-stamp issue marks the 50th anniversary of this tireless campaigner becoming

the first Aboriginal Australian to be knighted, in 1972. By the time this honour was reprised with the prestigious Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, in 1977, Nicholls had already received an MBE (1957) and OBE (1968) for his services to Aboriginal people, and had been appointed Governor of South Australia (1976). He was the first Aboriginal Australian to hold a vice-regal position, though regrettably ill health forced him to retire less than a year later. It was a fitting appointment for one so committed to serving the community.

The inquisitive, endearing Budgerigar (Melopsittacus undulatus) is a small parrot native to the drier regions of Australia. In the wild, budgerigars are green and yellow, with black markings on the nape, back and wings. Budgies are one of the world's most popular pets and have been selectively bred in a range of colour combinations, including yellow, blue, violet, grey and white. Approximately two million Australians own a pet Budgerigar. The birds are also widely exhibited by Budgerigar fanciers in competitive

shows. The Australian National Budgerigar Council (ANBC) was formed in 1982, and in 1991 a national exhibition standard was approved. The ANBC has around 2,000 members and its Annual Championship Show is hosted in turn by one of seven different zones throughout Australia.

The photographs shown in the stamp designs are from photographer Leila Jeffreys' exhibition *High Society*, which was shown at Sydney's Olsen Gallery and Olsen Gruin in New York, USA, in


2019. This exhibition focused exclusively on the Budgerigar, and included a video work of a Budgerigar flock, entitled Nature Is Not a Place to Visit. It Is Home.

Jeffreys has published two books showcasing her work: Birdland (2015) and Des Oiseaux - Leila Jeffreys (2020). In 2019, the Australian Broadcasting Corporation screened the documentary Bird Nerd: The Art of Leila Jeffreys and her work is held in many collections, both nationally and internationally.

The stamp photographs are tributes to much-loved pet budgerigars, showing the wide colour variation achieved through selective breeding. From left to right, The Tweets are golden-face blues, Bluey and Liquorice are sky blues and Celery is a single-factor golden face. The original photographs are large at 91 x 72 cm and 112 x 89 cm; they are printed on archival fibre-based cotton rag paper.





Association football, also referred to as "soccer" in Australia, is considered the most popular sport on a global scale, played by an estimated 250 million players in more than 200 countries. The first Australian men's national football team took the field in 1922, in New Zealand. The team, comprising players from New South Wales and Queensland (and incorporating those team colours into the playing kit), played 14 games, including three friendly internationals or "Tests". The first Test was played in Dunedin, on

17 June 1922, with New Zealand winning the series. It was not until 1965 that the men's national team would compete for a place at a Fédération Internationale de Football Association (FIFA) World Cup, qualifying for finals on five subsequent occasions: 1974 (by which time the nickname "Socceroos" was in regular use), 2006, 2010, 2014 and 2018. The Socceroos will participate in a playoff round in June, with the hope of qualifying for the 2022 World Cup.

Many of us associate warm summer days with the chorus of noisy cicadas. This final, brief phase of the cicada's life usually lasts two to four weeks. Most of its life is spent as a nymph, living underground, sometimes for several years.

This issue features three of the approximately 1,000 cicada species that occur in Australia, which has the greatest diversity of this group than anywhere else on Earth. The orange-and-black Masked Devil cicada is one of several colour morphs of *Cyclochila australasiae*.

It is found in native and exotic trees and bushes in mountainous areas and coastal lowland districts of New South Wales. The beautiful, aptly named Golden Emperor cicada (*Anapsaltoda pulchra*) is endemic to Queensland's Wet Tropics, where it lives in rainforest trees. Endemic to south-west Western Australia, the Sandgrinder cicada (*Arenopsaltria fullo*), named for the grating call of the male, inhabits small trees in open heathland on sandy soils.




In 2022, it will be 75 years since the establishment of Australia's Antarctic research program. It began with the founding of the Australian National Antarctic Research Expeditions (ANARE), in 1947, now known as the Australian Antarctic Program. The principal objective of the first voyage, which comprised two parties, was to find a site for a permanent station in the Australian Antarctic Territory (AAT) to support research and exploration. It resulted in sub-Antarctic bases at Heard and Macquarie

Islands, built in 1948 and 1947 respectively;
Australia's first base in the AAT, Mawson research station, was established in 1954.
ANARE also led to the creation of the Australian Antarctic Division, which has coordinated all Australian activities in Antarctica since 1948.
Today, a diverse research program is executed across a range of terrestrial, marine and atmospheric sciences at the year-round Mawson, Casey and Davis stations, and on Macquarie Island.



On 22 August 1872, the Overland Telegraph line between Adelaide and Darwin was finally connected. It was the result of years of planning and 23 months of arduous construction through the arid centre of the continent and the wet, mosquito-infested terrain of the Top End. The telegraph involved 36,000 poles being erected across 2,839 kilometres, from Port Augusta in the south to Darwin in the north, through territory virtually unexplored by Europeans.

Charles Todd, South Australia's Superintendent of Telegraphs and the Postmaster-General, was the visionary responsible for bringing the project to realisation, accomplished within a mere two years of the first pole being planted. This huge logistical achievement has been called the greatest engineering feat of 19th-century Australia. It dramatically transformed the speed and breadth of communications in the country, and, within two months of opening, with the rest of the world via an undersea cable from Darwin to Java.










