Welcome to the first edition of the *Stamp Bulletin* for 2023. We're excited to be beginning another year of philately and collectables.

Included in this edition is the Native Animals definitive stamp issue, to be released in December 2022 ahead of new postage rates, which will take effect in January 2023. Details are on page four.

The first stamp issue for release in 2023 is the latest in our Special Occasions series – flexible stamp designs, which are suitable for celebrations and key life events or for everyday mailing. These new designs will also be available as part of the Personalised Stamps™ service.

The Year of the Rabbit begins on 22 January 2023. In the lead-up, we're releasing an issue of three stamp designs, which incorporate symbols associated with longevity, prosperity and happiness. The cartoon-inspired rabbit designs are sure to delight both collectors and those celebrating this vibrant cultural festival. The Year of the Rabbit collectables include ready-made New Year greetings.

Our first Norfolk Island stamp issue for the year focuses on avian extinction, presenting historical illustrations of two extinct bird species, which once inhabited this island territory.

Birds are also featured in our Fairy-wrens stamp issue. Fairy-wrens are beautiful, small and intelligent songbirds, located in diverse habitats across Australia. The stamp subjects include the iconic Superb Fairy-wren, well known for its dazzling blue plumage.

Our rich sporting history is on display in Sporting Treasures. These stamps present key items associated with some Australian sporting heroes from across the past century: Hubert Opperman, Jack Brabham, Evonne Goolagong Cawley and Kurt Fearnley.

We also present upcoming licensed stamp packs and numismatics in this edition, including a set of five Peter Brock/Holden postal numismatic covers, each featuring an Australian penny.

Native Animals

Australia is home to around two-thirds of the more than 330 marsupial species that occur worldwide. Marsupials are non-placental mammals that give birth to young at an early stage of development. The newborn crawls up the mother's abdomen and attaches itself to a teat, usually located in a pouch, where it continues to grow and develop. This stamp issue features three marsupial species and one monotreme (egg-laying mammal), all of which are endemic to Australia and listed on the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) Red List.

Resembling an otter but with an unusual duck-like bill and webbed feet, the Platypus (*Ornithorhynchus anatinus*) baffled European scientists when they first encountered it. Found in freshwater systems in Australia's eastern states, this monotreme was categorised near threatened by the IUCN in 2014. The Platypus is one of only two Australian monotremes, the other being the Short-beaked Echidna (*Tachyglossus aculeatus*).

Also listed as at significant risk is the Mountain Pygmy Possum (*Burramys parvus*), a tiny

marsupial adapted to live exclusively in Australia's alpine zone. It is the only surviving species in the genus Burramys and Australia's only hibernating marsupial. One threat to its survival is the recent precipitous decline in number of the Bogong Moth, the possum's main food source in spring.

Listed as vulnerable and restricted to the southwest region of Western Australia, including Rottnest and Bald Islands, the Quokka (Setonix brachyurus) can climb trees in search of food such as acacia leaves, although it prefers succulents from areas recently burned. The Eastern Quoll (Dasyurus viverrinus), is a medium-sized carnivorous marsupial that was once common throughout south-eastern parts of the country. Today, this endangered species occurs naturally in the wild only in Tasmania, though conservation efforts operate on the southern mainland. It prefers dry grasslands and forests where pasture grubs are plentiful.





Lunar New Year is the most important of the traditional festivals celebrated by Asian cultures throughout the world. The Year of the Rabbit begins on 22 January 2023 and marks the beginning of a seven-day celebration, which includes catching up with family, preparing special meals and giving the gift of money in bright red envelopes.

Of the animals in the 12-year cycle, it is the Rabbit that is thought to be witty, vigilant, and ingenious.

The Rabbit is the fourth animal in the Chinese Zodiac because according to the legend, he was fourth to cross the river in the Jade Emperor's race.

The stamp designs are inspired by cartoon characters popular in Asian cultures. The lines are bold, modern and bright, with the subjects representing three lucky Rabbit characters based on three Chinese gods, Shuxing, Luxing and Fuxing (longevity, prosperity and happiness).

FIRST DAY OF ISSUI 31 JANUARY 2023 NORFOLK ISLAND NSW 2899 Norfolk Island has an unfortunate record for avian extinctions, and the stamps feature two birds long lost from the territory. The Norfolk Island Kaka (*Nestor productus*) was a large parrot at around 38 centimetres in length, closely related to New Zealand's extant Kaka. It occurred on both Norfolk and Phillip Islands and was last observed in the wild during the early decades of the 19th century. Habitat destruction, through land clearing, and hunting in the former penal colony are thought responsible for its extinction. The Norfolk Island Pigeon (*Hemiphaga novaeseelandiae spadicea*) was a subspecies of New Zealand's extant native pigeon, the Kereru. Particularly large at around 50 centimetres in length, this glossy, brightly coloured pigeon was once common and is believed to have become extinct around 1900. Hunting by both feral cats and humans was the most likely cause for its disappearance.


This stamp issue celebrates some of Australia's sporting champions, signalling their place in national sporting history through a selection of key items with which they are associated. This will be familiar to collectors who remember the 2005 Sports Treasures issue, and something of a companion to it, spanning four sports through excellence achieved over nearly a century.

Hubert Opperman was Australian cycling royalty in the 1920s and 1930s, winning the Australian Pro Road Championship in 1924, 1925, 1927 and 1929; the Bol d'Or 24-hour Paris in 1928; and the Paris–Brest–Paris in 1931, breaking all records. He set the 24-hour world record in Victoria in 1927 on the Malvern Star "Tour de France" model road bike shown on the stamp.


Jack Brabham was a three-time Formula One world champion, in 1959, 1960 and 1966, and the only F1 champion to win in a car of his own making. In 1967, he designed the Repco-Brabham Tasman BT23A-1 prototype featured on the stamp. He raced it in the Tasman series and it led directly to BT24 model.

Evonne Goolagong Cawley was the first Indigenous Australian to compete in international tennis. She won seven grand slam tournaments: the Australian Open four times (1974–77), Wimbledon in 1971 and 1980, and the French Open in 1971. She played with the Dunlop Maxply Fort racquet through the early 1970s.

Kurt Fearnley competed at five Paralympic Games between 2000 and 2016, won seven world championships and competed in more than 30 marathons during his long career on the track. He won gold at the 2008 Beijing Paralympic Games in the racing wheelchair shown on the stamp.





Fairy-wrens (genus *Malurus*) are small, beautiful and intelligent songbirds, which range in size between around 11.5 and 15 centimetres. The breeding plumages of males come in dazzling displays of blues, as well as purple, orangey-reds, black, white and chestnut.

These omnivorous birds are found across diverse habitats across Australia. Some species, such as the Splendid Fairy-wren (*Malurus splendens*), have a large range across eastern, central, and western Australia. Others, such as the Purple-crowned Fairy-wren (*Malurus coronatus*), have a very small range.

In fact, populations of the Purple-crowned Fairywren are not only localised but also in decline – the Kimberley region sub-species *M. c. coronatus* is endangered and subspecies *M. c. macgillivrayi*, near the Gulf of Carpentaria, is threatened.

The Red-backed Fairy-wren (Malurus melanocephalus), the smallest of the Australian fairy-wrens, is common throughout northern and eastern Australia, where it is found within a wide variety of tall grassy habitats. Both males and females of the species are highly promiscuous,

though temptation is thought to be tempered somewhat when breeding pairs sing a duet.

The Lovely Fairy-wren (Malurus amabilis) is one of several chestnut-winged fairy-wrens, distinguishable by its blue-and-white females (most females are a dullish brown). Breeding males are unique among Australian fairy-wrens because all retain their bright plumage throughout the year.

Perhaps the best-known species is the Superb Fairy-wren (*Malurus cyaneus*). Known colloquially


as the Blue Wren, it was voted "Australia's favourite bird" in a 2021 poll. The Superb Fairy-wren is found in open eucalypt woodland forests throughout south-eastern Australia as well as in Tasmania, King Island, Flinders Island and Kangaroo Island. This bird also frequents parks and gardens; it is the only species of fairy-wren to have successfully adapted to suburban environments, where it is attracted to dense shrubs and small trees such as paperbarks and tea trees. Adult males of the species become bright blue in time for the breeding season.
