Hello Collectors

Welcome to a new edition of the *Stamp Bulletin*, presenting upcoming Australian and territories stamp issues, as well as themed collectables.

In March, we celebrate the “golden age” of travel posters, which occurred in the 1930s (and a little either side of). These vibrant Art Deco posters played a significant role in promoting Australia as a tourist destination, despite the hardships of the era. These posters are also highly prized collector items.

Three striking stamp designs for the Australian Antarctic Territory present three of Sidney Nolan's *Antarctica* series of paintings. Nolan visited the icy continent in January of 1964 and spent eight days recording his impressions on postcard-size watercolours. The resulting series of 68 paintings were completed on Nolan's return, over a period of six months.

We also mark a century of Legacy in Australia. This important charitable organisation and its volunteers work tirelessly to assist families of servicemen and servicewomen.

Also released in March is a large minisheet presenting the 10 designs of the Cocos (Keeling) Islands Reef Fish stamp issue. A trimmed-down version of the minisheet is presented on a first day cover.

In April, a stamp issue of three designs presents different types of solar eclipse, the issue being timed with a rare hybrid solar eclipse, which is due to occur on 20 April 2023, viewable from the Exmouth peninsula, in Western Australia. Collectables include a medallion cover.

There are also new licensed stamp packs, available for your collecting enjoyment and covering a range of themes.

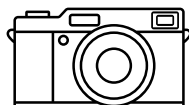

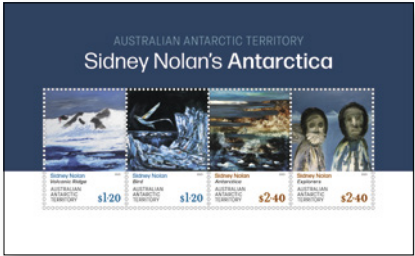
The 1930s were times of great hardship in Australia, with a fall in wool and wheat prices and high unemployment that reached a staggering 32 per cent in 1932. Against this bleak backdrop was a source of optimism, in the form of travel opportunities portrayed in posters, produced largely during the 1930s (but also during the late 1920s and the early 1940s), in what became known as the “golden age” of Australian poster design.

Travel posters commissioned by the newly formed Australian National Travel Association

(ANTA), the Victorian Railways, and other state-based tourism and railway boards, sought to promote tourism and recreation as both achievable and desirable. Posters were also produced by ANTA, Qantas and others for the international market, promoting Australia as a sunny yet sophisticated destination. The commercial artists featured in this stamp issue include two of the most popular and influential of the era – James Northfield (1887–1973) and Percy Trompf (1902–64).

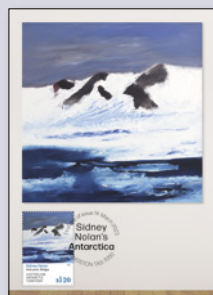
Australian Antarctic Territory Sidney Nolan's *Antarctica*

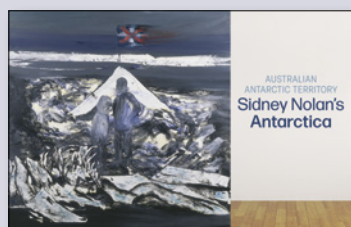

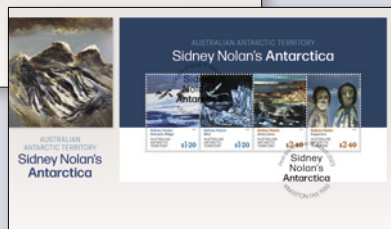

In January 1964, Sidney Nolan travelled with writer and fellow Australian Alan Moorehead to Antarctica. At a time of restricted travel to Antarctica, they flew with a US naval supply party to McMurdo base, via Christchurch, and spent eight days at the US stations. On Nolan's return to his London studio in April, he immediately set to work, producing a series of 68 paintings in oil on composition board by September. His Antarctica series represents not a passive, white landscape,

but an environment full of muscular forms, dynamic elements and intense and often-brooding colours. At his hand, the polar landscape is vast and ever-changing, and the deft simplicity of his explorers suggests humanity's insignificance in this consuming and radically unfamiliar place. Nolan's paintings are less documentary records than existential landscapes; they are portraits of the Antarctic experience, internal as much as external experiences of the icy continent.

In its wreath of laurel, with its points inverted in remembrance, is the garland (recognition) of honour; that is the meed (reward) of those who gave their lives for their country.



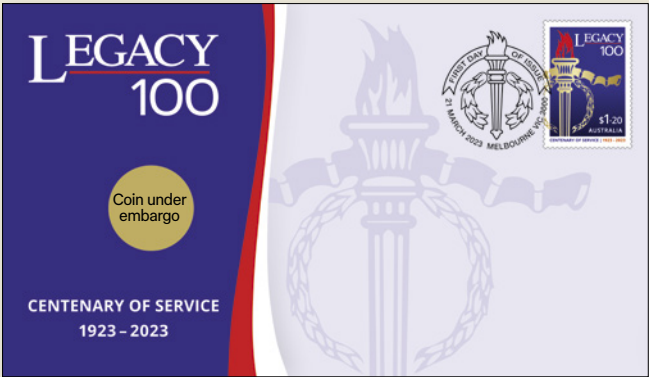

Most of us are familiar with Legacy Week, when every September volunteers take to the streets to sell special badges and other items to raise awareness and funds for Legacy. In 2023 Legacy is celebrating its centenary. A national charitable organisation, Legacy was first established in 1923 in Melbourne to provide services to the families of Australian Defence Force veterans killed or wounded in World War I.

In the Great War of 1914–18 some 60,000 Australian service personnel lost their lives and more than

150,000 were wounded, with many dying soon after. This left tens of thousands of veterans, widows and children without adequate support. In 1923, returned serviceman Major General Sir John Gellibrand formed the Remembrance Club in Hobart to aid those who suffered because of war. Another returning soldier, Lieutenant General Sir Stanley Savage, was inspired to establish a similar club in Melbourne, which was named Legacy.

Legacy is still caring for tens of thousands of partners and families who have lost their loved

ones or have been adversely impacted by conflicts across the globe, including the Korean War, Malayan Emergency, Vietnam War, campaigns in Iraq and Afghanistan and in peacekeeping operations. Today, there are 44 Legacy Clubs throughout Australia and one in London, providing emotional, social and financial support. Legacy currently supports 43,000 individuals and families across Australia, supported by over 3,600 volunteer members or Legatees.

Funds to support Legacy's work are raised by a variety of methods, the most notable being the sale

of goods during Legacy Week. Legacy also solicits donations from the public to assist with its mission.

As part of the 2023 centenary celebrations, the Legacy Centenary Torch Relay 2023 will take place from coast to coast, hand to hand, in a remarkable journey spanning more than 55,000 kilometres through 100 locations and carried by approximately 1,500 Torch Bearer. Beginning in Pozières, France, in the lead-up to Anzac Day 2023, the Centenary Torch will travel to the Legacy Club in London before stopping at the 44 Legacy Clubs throughout Australia.

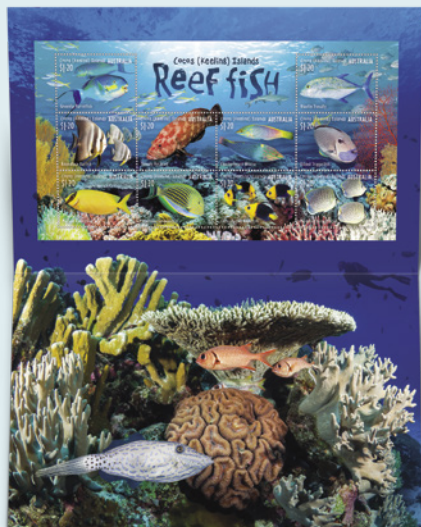

Cocos (Keeling) Islands is in the eastern Indian Ocean, near the western edge of the Pacific. Its remote location at the interface of the Pacific and Indian Oceans and the expanse between Cocos and Indonesia are fundamental to the composition of its marine life; while it is composed of many species common to the Indo-West Pacific, it is also home to many that do not occur elsewhere in the Indian Ocean.

Relatively little human-induced disturbance to the Cocos marine environment means its coral reef system is healthy, providing good habitat for the species it supports. Of the several hundred fish species that occupy the reef waters, this stamp issue shows just 10, including the endemic Cocos Pygmy Angelfish. The diverse and colourful species in the stamps belong to nine families of reef fish. Together they build an imagined subaquatic scene in the clear tropical waters of Cocos.

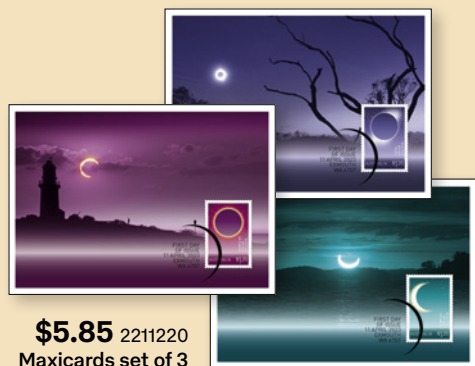

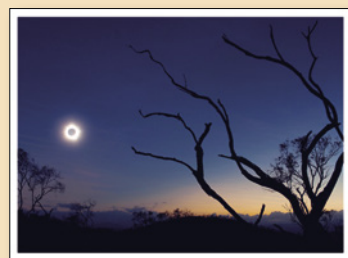

A solar eclipse occurs when the Moon passes between the Sun and Earth. A partial solar eclipse takes place when the Moon misaligns with the Sun. An annular solar eclipse occurs when the Moon is at its farthest point from the Earth on its elliptical orbit. The Sun appears as a burning ring around the Moon's circumference. During a total eclipse, the Moon completely blocks the Sun, leaving only the hazy white corona visible.

The rarest of eclipses is a hybrid solar eclipse, during which an annular eclipse becomes a total eclipse and then returns to annularity.

On 20 April 2023 a hybrid eclipse will be visible over Western Australia's Exmouth peninsula, with the total eclipse visible for only 62 seconds. The eclipse will start its path of totality in the remote Southern Ocean, completing its journey in the north-eastern Pacific.

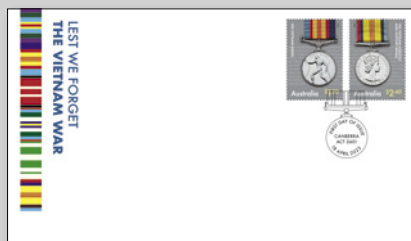

The Vietnam War (1955–75) was fought between South Vietnam (backed by the United States) and the Viet Cong, the communist-led insurgent force supported by the North Vietnamese Army. The Viet Cong sought to unify the country after the partition that resulted from the First Indochina War (1946–54).

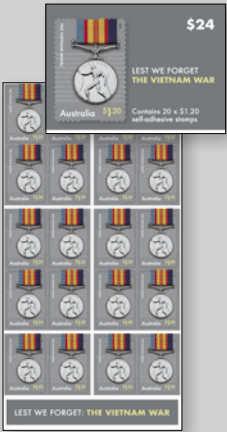
Australian support for South Vietnam was in the context of a desire by the United States and other nations to stop the spread of communism in Europe and Asia. While Australia didn't enter the war until 1962, it was to become our longest conflict of the

20th century. More than 60,000 Australians served in Vietnam, of which 523 were killed and more than 3,000 wounded.

Australia's initial military commitment in South Vietnam was a team of 30 military advisers, the Australian Army Training Team Vietnam, who arrived during July and August of 1962. The subsequent Australian commitment consisted predominantly of Army personnel, but also significant numbers of Air Force and Navy personnel, plus civilians, including those providing medical and dental aid, education,

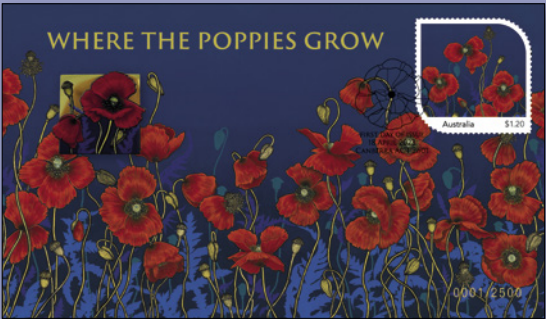

and construction and agricultural assistance to the Vietnamese people.

Australian forces were withdrawn in 1971, with the last arriving home in March of 1972. In January 1973, 50 years ago this year, Australia officially issued a proclamation to mark the end of Australia's involvement in the war. However, in 1975, due to the fall of Saigon to the communists, elements of the Royal Australian Air Force returned to carry out evacuations and assist refugees, before embassy staff were finally evacuated on 25 April 1975.

The Vietnam War, including the introduction of a selective conscription scheme, was the cause of significant social and political dissent. Many veterans were left with long-term impacts to their health. To honour all Australians who served in the Vietnam War, the stamps in this issue present two key campaign medals: The Vietnam Medal (reverse shown) and the Vietnam Logistic and Support Medal (obverse shown). In the background of the stamps are main base locations and areas associated with the recipient classes for each medal.

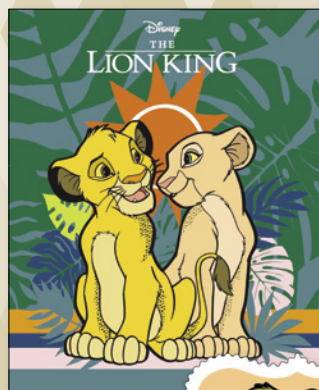




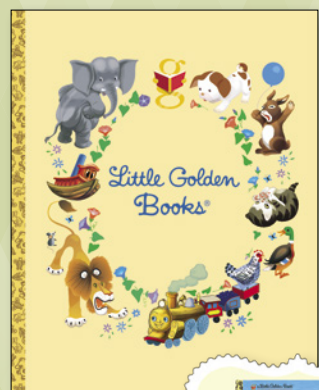

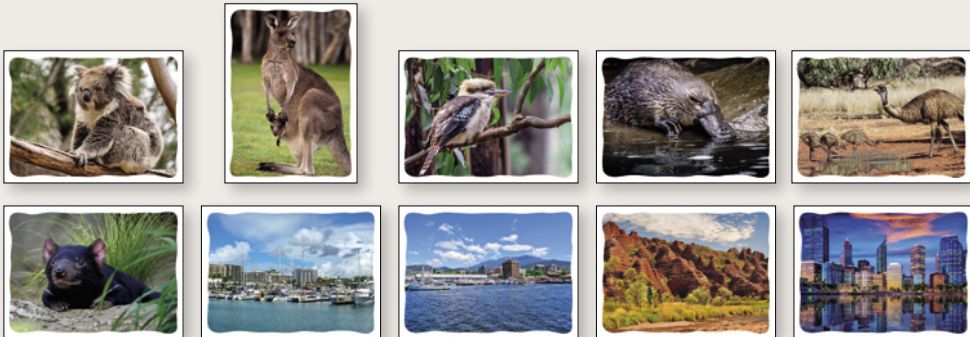
