### **Hello Collectors**

Welcome to the May edition of the *Stamp Bulletin* for 2023.

In this edition, we showcase the stamps and collectables for Australian Legends of Supercars, released on 27 April 2023. The stamp designs honour four living legends of Supercars racing, whose record-setting achievements across the decades are inspiring a new generation of drivers and who have contributed to the community through education, advocacy and charity work.

In May, we present three Christmas Island caves, which are popular with speleologists and an important habitat for fauna. We feature fascinating and colourful peacock spiders, known for their "dancing" antics, and we showcase four Australian jellyfish species.

In June, we present three stamp designs of extinct mammals, including the iconic Thylacine (*Thylacinus cynocephalus*), which was not a tiger but a pouched marsupial, related to kangaroos and driven to extinction, largely due to hunting by humans.

Still-life paintings by renowned Australian artists Margaret Olley and John Perceval are the subjects of two stamps released in June. We will also release an issue of two stamps showcasing endemic plant species found in the Norfolk Island Botanic Garden.

Working towards a sustainable future is important for current and future generations. Three new stamp designs in June focus on environmental sustainability, specifically biodiversity, indigenous land management and renewable energy technologies, each of which is at the forefront of Australia's current sustainability efforts.

In this edition we also feature a range of exciting AFL Coin Hunt collectables, as part of a collaboration with the Royal Australian Mint. The release of these new coins in May will interest coin and sporting memorabilia collectors alike. Lucky customers may also find special coins in their change at participating Post Offices. Full details begin on page 26.

Supercars racing is the top category of Australian motorsport, and Australia is the only place in the world where these cars compete. Born out of touring car racing and now featuring purpose-built, high-powered coupe-shaped race cars, Supercars racing features versatile, skilful, athletic drivers capable of handling these powerful machines, which can reach speeds of 300 kilometres per hour on the fastest straights in Australia. General Motors' retirement of the Holden brand, and the subsequent end of the famed Holden versus Ford racing rivalry, paves the way for the much-anticipated arrival of Gen3 cars in Supercars racing – a new era of V8-powered, front-engine, rear-wheel drive Ford Mustangs and Chevrolet Camaros, which will more closely resemble their road-going versions, while still ensuring close, competitive racing.



With a new era about to dawn, this year's Australia Post Australian Legends Award honours four living legends of Supercars racing – Allan Moffat OBE, Dick Johnson AM, Mark Skaife OAM and Craig Lowndes OAM – whose record-setting achievements across the decades are inspiring the next generation. Not only have these racing drivers achieved excellence on the track in the Bathurst 1000, the Australian Touring Car Championship and the Repco Supercars Championship, but they have also made significant contributions off the track, through industry involvement, advocacy, education and charity work.

The stamp designs feature a portrait of each Legend during his racing career, together with a background image of an iconic racing car.

In recent years, peacock spiders have become something of a social media phenomenon. Measuring around just two to five millimetres in length, these brightly coloured and patterned jumping spiders are named for the peacock-like display adult males use to seduce potential mates. In a complex courtship dance, the male will first raise and slowly wave his third pair of legs. During his finely choreographed spectacle, he will expand, elevate and wave his dazzling coloured abdomen, signalling wildly with his raised legs as he moves back and forth, from side to side.

He belongs to genus *Maratus*, which currently comprises around 96 species, with 20 known species still to be named. All but one are endemic to Australia. This issue is a taster of the magnificent diversity of *Maratus*.

When we think of jellyfish, most of us think of their sting and slime, and they elicit feels of dread and fear. But there's another world to jellyfish, for these are marine creatures of great beauty and mystery.

To those of us inquisitive to learn more, jellyfish can be an endless source of fascination, from their life cycle and knack for survival to their ability to clone. While cloning is nothing short of a miracle on its own, jellies can clone in at least 13 different ways, and some species are truly biologically immortal. Australia has a high percentage of jellyfish that are endemic; that is, found nowhere else. Each has its own biology and ecology, its own habits and habitats, its own captivating story. There are at least 1,000 jellyfish species drifting on the currents around Australia, and new species are always being described and added to the literature on Australian marine fauna. In this stamp issue, we illustrate just four of these wonders of the sea.



The causes of extinction, since British settlement, have changed over time. Hunting by humans contributed to several early animal extinctions, aided by bounty schemes during the 1800s. Climate change has contributed to some recent extinctions, as well as habitat loss and introduced species (for mammals, especially cats and foxes). Australia's modern environmental protection legislation was established in 1999 but has not necessarily curbed all pressures on threatened species, including habitat clearing and bushfires.

This stamp issue presents three extinct mammals, including the Thylacine (*Thylacinus cynocephalus*), which was the world's largest carnivorous marsupial. The stamp illustrations are lithographs from John Gould's significant work, first published in 1863, *The Mammals of Australia*.

### Still-life Paintings Margaret Olley and John Perceval

This stamp issue marks the birth centenary of Margaret Olley (1923–2011) and John Perceval (1923–2000), two of Australia's renowned artists of the 20th century. These contemporaries each had a distinctive painterly style and focus, making their work highly recognisable.

Lismore-born Olley studied art in Sydney and Paris. Her carefully composed, strikingly coloured still lifes and domestic scenes made her works popular with the critics and public alike. The self-taught John Perceval was a member of the avant-garde Angry Penguins group and Contemporary Art Society in Melbourne. While known for his textured landscapes and joyous ceramic angels, Perceval also made a series of sunflower paintings, defined by the same energetic brushwork as his landscapes.

### Norfolk Island Botanic Garden

Norfolk Island Botanic Garden was originally a 0.6-hectare private garden cleared and planted by Mrs Annie Moore in the 1950s. After she left the island in 1975, Norfolk Island Administration maintained the gardens until 1986, at which time it became part of the Norfolk Island National Park and Botanic Garden. In 1993 an adjoining 4.9 hectares was purchased to complete the current 5.5 hectares. Most of the garden's plant species are native and many are rare and endemic to the Norfolk Island group. The garden also includes a boardwalk trail, subtropical rainforest and Discovery Centre, where visitors can learn more about the island's precious flora and fauna. Shown on the stamps are the Pepper Tree (*Piper excelsum* subsp. *psittacorum*) and the critically endangered Phillip Island Hibiscus (*Hibiscus insularis*).

Sustainability is concerned with how we live environmentally, socially and economically. It's a goal that seeks to ensure that individuals, businesses and communities are living in a way that meets our needs, without comprising the ability of future generations to do so.

There are international targets and conventions that seek to improve sustainability, to which Australia is a party, including the Convention on Biological Diversity (the Aichi Targets), the Paris Climate Agreement and the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals.

The stylised scenes in this stamp issue focus on environmental sustainability. The biodiversity stamp scene is inspired by Lake Connewarre, Victoria, the site of trials for the release of the critically endangered Orange-bellied Parrot (*Neophema chrysogaster*) and the site of tree planting as habitat for Koalas. The wetland plants featured are favoured by the parrot and by the Growling Grass Frog (*Litoria raniformis*), which is vulnerable in Victoria.

Indigenous land management is represented by the Indigenous Ranger Program, through which more than 125 ranger groups draw upon traditional knowledge to sustain the local environment, through weed control and plant regeneration, cool burning, surveying plants and animals, and more.

In 2021, 29 per cent of Australia's total electricity generation was from renewable energy sources, such as solar, wind and hydro – the highest

percentage on record in Australia. The stamp scene incorporates examples of renewable energy technologies, such as community solar batteries, solar PV fields, wind turbines, electric vehicles (charged with Green Power electricity) and sugar cane for biofuel.


