Hello Collectors

Welcome to the new edition of the *Stamp Bulletin*, where we present new stamps for Australia and Australian external territories.

Among the issues included in this edition is a set of two stamps featuring the White-breasted Waterhen of the Cocos (Keeling) Islands.

September is Australia Post Collecting Month, with the month set aside to celebrate the popular pastimes of stamp and coin collecting. This year, we invite you to explore five *Aussie Big Things*, a companion stamp issue to the popular 2007 *Big Things* issue. This time, the stamps are illustrated by well-known artist Nigel Buchanan. You are also invited to hunt for an elusive Giant Murray Cod coloured coin.

An upcoming stamp issue presents a wide range of collectables to mark a century of entertainment with *Disney IOO*. Collectables include character-inspired collections, postcards, medallion covers and postal numismatic covers. The fun and colour of all things Disney is captured in the four stamp designs, each depicting a favourite Australian destination.

A set of six stamps honours the faithful service of the late Queen Elizabeth II. The Queen Elizabeth II: In Memoriam stamps highlight important traits and attributes displayed during Her Majesty's remarkable reign. We also mark the birth 150 years ago of Australia's First Olympian: Edwin Flack and pay tribute to his amazing achievements in the first Olympic Games of the modern era, held in Paris in 1896.

This year also commemorates the *Centenary of Public Broadcast Radio* in Australia. A single stamp design allows for nostalgic reminiscing of the impact public broadcast radio had on everyday life.

Our final stamp issue in this edition is *Poppies of Remembrance*, honouring the service and sacrifice of men, women, and animals in times of human conflict and hardship. The different versions of the Flanders Poppy are featured in this set of three stamp designs.

Dotting the countryside are oversized manmade statues of animals and objects affectionately referred to as "Big Things". Following on from the stamp issue released in 2007, this companion issue is colourful and entertaining.

The Big Tasmanian Devil stands at the entrance to the Trowunna Wildlife Sanctuary near Mole Creek, in northern Tasmania. The sanctuary is dedicated to the care and conservation of the region's native wildlife. Although not a threatened species, the Australian Magpie is one of Australia's bestloved birds, noted for its tuneful, yodelling call. The bird's defensive behaviour gives name to the Big Swoop sculpture located in Garema Place, in central Canberra. The structure was made by local artist Yanni Pounartzis, at 2.4 metres high, 3.5 metres long and weighing half of a metric tonne.



Giant Koala is in the western Victorian town of Dadswells Bridge. Made in 1989 by Dutch sculptor Ben Van Zetten, it is composed of bronze and fibreglass supported by a steel frame. At 14 by eight metres, this massive structure is more a building than a sculpture.

The city of Swan Hill is home to the Giant Murray Cod. Fifteen metres long, three metres wide and five metres high, the steel and fibreglass structure highlights awareness that numbers of this species, once common in the Murray–Darling River system, have been greatly reduced.

The final Big Thing is the Big Jumping Crocodile, located at Original Adelaide River Queen Jumping Crocodile Cruises, at the Adelaide River Bridge, Wak Wak, east of Darwin in the Northern Territory. The sculpture represents an imitation of a real crocodile leaping out of the water to catch food.



This issue of six stamps honours the life of Queen Elizabeth II highlighting important traits and attributes displayed during her remarkable reign.

Born Elizabeth Alexandra Mary on 21 April 1926, Queen Elizabeth reigned as Queen of the United Kingdom and the Commonwealth for 70 years and 214 days. The Queen has featured on a greater number of Australian stamps than any other person, commencing with the one penny (1d) Australian stamp in honour of her wedding to the Duke of Edinburgh (1921–2021). By the time of the Queen's accession, in 1952, it was a long-established policy to feature the monarch on most Australian definitive stamps, including the base-rate value. As such, the Queen was depicted on lower denomination definitive stamps issued between 1953 and 1971 and on all base-rate definitive stamps until 1973, when this practice was abolished. Only two royal-themed commemorative stamps were produced between 1973 and 1979. In 1980 an annual commemorative stamp series was introduced, the first of which commemorated the Queen's birthday.

The White-breasted Waterhen is a waterbird from the Rallidae family, around 30 centimetres in length, with a distribution from the Indian subcontinent east through southern China, and most of South-East Asia. The nominate subspecies (*Amauronrnis p. phoenicurus*) can be found on the Cocos (Keeling) Islands and Christmas Island. First recorded in the 1990s, the White-breasted Waterhen is now plentiful on the Cocos (Keeling) Islands, where it also breeds.

A timid water bird 24-28 centimetres in length, its upper parts are dark slatebrown with a white face and breast, and deep red eyes. It has chestnut flanks and undertail coverts. The bill is green or yellow, red at the base, and the legs are yellowish green. The bird has large feet and flies with its legs dangling.









Australia's First Olympian Edwin Flack

This year we commemorate 150 years since the birth of Australia's first Olympian, Edwin Harold Flack (5 November 1873–10 January 1935).

Flack was born in London, England. The family migrated to Australia in 1874 and settled in Melbourne. After leaving school in 1892, Edwin Flack joined the family accountancy firm with further training taken in London. He was the only Australian athlete to participate in the first Olympic Games of the modern era winning the 800 metres and 1500 metres running races, coming third in the doubles tennis, and competing in the marathon, all accomplished as an independent athlete.

After his Olympic triumphs, Flack returned to Australia, becoming senior partner at Flack and Flack accounting firm (now PricewaterhouseCoopers).

Generations of Australians have grown up with Disney, from the early days of cinema and television to today's multimedia experiences. In this exciting collaboration between Australia Post and Disney, four postage stamps have been issued to celebrate a century of our favourite iconic animated characters.

Walter Elias Disney was born in Chicago, Illinois, USA, on 5 December 1901 and discovered his talent for drawing at an early age. After World War I Disney worked as an advertising cartoonist founding an art and animation company. The enterprise was not financially successful, and in 1923, Walt headed to Los Angeles. Walt and his brother, Roy O Disney, worked on making animated films and later founded the Disney Brothers Cartoon Studio, later named the Walt Disney Studio.

The first and most famous of Disney's characters is Mickey Mouse. Walt wanted to name his new character Oswald, until his wife, Lily, suggested

the name of Mickey. Mickey Mouse made his first appearance in 1928, in *Steamboat Willie*, the world's first cartoon with fully synchronised sound. This short was made just a year after the first feature-length motion picture "talkie", *The Jazz Singer*. The public adored the little mouse, and Mickey became a national and global sensation, with animated shorts, a comic strip and merchandise bearing Mickey's signature grin and sunny outlook. Minnie Mouse accompanied him from the beginning, and he soon gained co-stars, including Pluto the dog, Goofy and Donald Duck. In 1934, the year of Donald Duck's creation, Walt Disney was honoured with an Academy Award for creating Mickey Mouse – the first of more than 140 such accolades.

The ever-popular Mickey was the impetus for the creation of the Mickey Mouse Club, an American variety television show that first screened in 1955.

The program was popular on Australian television, which began broadcasting in 1956, and resulted in two successful Australian tours of the youthful

"Mouseketeers", in 1959 and 1960.

Early Australian television also introduced us to "Disneyland", hosted by Walt Disney himself, featuring four rotating segments: Frontierland, Fantasyland, Adventureland and Tomorrowland. These reflected the divisions within the Disneyland amusement park in Anaheim, California – surely every Australian child's dream destination. Much has happened in the last 100 years, but Disney continues to delight and entertain us.







The newly formed Australian federal government introduced the *Wireless Telegraphy Act 1905*, with Amalgamated Wireless of Australia (AWA) granted the exclusive rights to operate a network of coastal maritime radio stations.

The first officially licensed radio station to go to air in Australia was 2SB Sydney on 23 November 1923. In 1924 the radio industry lobbied for the introduction of a system that allowed radio stations to be funded by listener fees ("A" licenses") and commercial stations to generate revenue through advertising ("B" licenses).

AWA became Australia's largest radio company, manufacturing radios for homes, transmitters for radio stations and wireless communications for cross-country to cross-continent communications, as well as for ships and the military. Radios for homes ranged from mantels to taller floor-standing consoles.



The Corn Poppy (*Papaver rhoeas*), best known as the Flanders Poppy, grew profusely in the trenches and on the battlefields of the Western Front. It is this flower that has become synonymous with war-related remembrance.

Yet historical accounts suggest that poppies were not present to any great extent in the fields of Flanders prior to World War I, due to the poor nature of the soil and the absence of nutrients. It is said that artillery shells and shrapnel agitated the earth and exposed seeds to the light needed to germinate.

Red poppies, however, are not the only poppies synonymous with remembrance. This stamp issue explores the red poppy, along with white (for peace and all war victims) and purple (for animals in war). Part of Standing Orders


