A colourful collection featuring three marine gastropod molluscs.

The three species of ovulids depicted in this release of stamps have smooth, shiny shells – egg-like in shape – and are most readily distinguished by their different colours. They are carnivorous and parasitic, feeding on various types of soft corals and sea fans or gorgonians. The photographs were taken by Brian R. Mayes in the waters of Nelson Bay, NSW.

# 50 Years of Colour TV

Celebrating five decades since Australia made the switch from black-and-white.

At midnight on 1 March 1975 – C-Day, as it was called – television officially burst into colour across Australia. We were years behind the rest of the world in adopting colour broadcasting, but quickly made up for lost time – by 1978, more than 64 per cent of households in Melbourne and Sydney had purchased a new PAL standard colour television set.



# Raptors – Birds of Prey

A collection that explores the fascinating world of Australia’s birds of prey.

Australia is home to some 36 species of raptors, including nocturnal raptors (which are active at night, such as owls) and diurnal raptors (which are active during the day, including hawks, harriers and falcons). This stamp series features three diurnal raptors: the Little Eagle, Grey Falcon and Black-breasted Buzzard. With keen eyesight, a broad wingspan and strong, sharp talons, diurnal raptors are skilled hunters, using various techniques to locate, pursue and seize their prey.







# Postcards from the Front

This release complements the 2022 issue, Postcards to the Front.

During World War I, some 330,000 Australians served overseas, and the letters and postcards they wrote became treasured keepsakes for their families and friends. The war years of 1914-18 coincided with the "golden age" of the postcard, and saw the production of millions of embroidered silk postcards. France was the largest source, and hundreds of designs catered specifically to members of the Australian, New Zealand, British, French, Canadian or South African armed forces.

# AAT Aurora Australis

A collection capturing the mesmerising beauty of this atmospheric phenomenon.

Aurora australis, also known as the southern lights, sees shimmering curtains of green, red and violet lights manifest in the night sky around the south magnetic pole. The awe-inspiring spectacle is best viewed in the Australian Antarctic Territory and Tasmania – the images on these stamps were taken from Casey Research Station, the closest permanent Antarctic station to Australia, by meteorologist Barend (Barry) Becker using time-lapse photography.






